General Information:

- Main Ring is 100'x200' with stone dust footing, Lower Ring is 110'x180' with stone dust footing.
- All regular hunter, equitation, jumper and warmup classes are \$15 per class. Hunter Derby, Medal, and Challenge classes are \$30 entry per class. All entries must pay a \$20 office fee.
- Both arenas are open for schooling on Friday from 1pm-7pm and in the morning until 15 minutes before the start time.
- Concessions will be offered on site.
- Limited stalls are available for the day at \$30/stall

Division Information:

Beginner Walk-trot: Open to riders under age 18 in their first year of showing, riders may not cross enter into other divisions.

Beginner Walk-trot-canter: Open to riders of any age in their first year of cantering at a horse show, riders may cross enter into Beginner Crossrails.

Open Walk Trot Canter: Open to any horse/rider combination.

Beginner Equitation Flat Challenge: Open to riders eligible for Beginner Walk-Trot-Canter or Beginner Crossrails Equitation.

Beginner Crossrails Equitation: Open to riders of any age in their first year of showing over fences, riders may cross enter into Walk-trot-canter. Classes are judged on the riders equitation and simple changes are allowed. Fences 18".

Mini Hunter Crossrails: Open to any horse/rider, to be judged on the horses manners and way of going, simple changes are allowed. Fences 18".

Open Hunter: Open to any horse/rider combination, fences 2' or 2'6".

Short/Long Stirrup: Open to junior or amateur riders in their first 2 years of showing over fences, simple changes are allowed. Fences 2' with no oxers.

Hopeful Hunter: Open to all riders, fences 2'3"

Pre-Child/Adult: Open to junior or amateur riders, fences 2'6".

Child/Adult: Open to junior or amateur riders, fences 2'9"

Equitation on the Flat Challenge: Open to junior or amateur riders eligible for classes at 2' or above.

Equitation medal: Open to junior or amateur riders with fence heights offered at 2', 2'3", 2'6" or 2'9". Course will contain bending lines, roll backs, trot jump, or other elements typically found in equitation courses. Riders may accumulate points toward year end medal finals.

Hunter Derby: Open to all horses and riders with fence heights offered at 2', 2'6" or 2'9". There will be two rounds with the first round being a classic round and the second round being a handy round. The top 12 horse/rider combinations will be invited to return for the handy round and scores from each round will be combined. Riders may accumulate points toward year end derby finals.

Jumper Classes: Offered at 2', 2'3", and 2'6", will be run as Table II, 2b.
