#### General Information:

Upper Ring is 100'x200' with stone dust footing, Lower Ring is 110'x180' with sand footing.

All regular hunter, equitation, and warmup classes are \$15 per class. Hunter Derby is \$30 entry with prize money being rewarded to the top 3 finishers.

Both arenas are open for schooling on Friday from 1pm-7pm and in the morning until 15 minutes before the start time.

Concessions will be offered on site by our IEA team members.

Limited stalls are available for the day at \$30/stall

#### Division Information:

Academy walk-trot, walk-trot-canter, and crossrails are for students riding their barn's lesson horses only. Simple changes are allowed in the crossrails division.

Walk-trot: Open to riders under age 18 in their first year of showing, riders may not cross enter into other divisions.

Walk-trot-canter: Open to riders of any age in their first year of cantering at a horse show, riders may cross enter into Pleasure Horse or Pony and Beginner Crossrails.

Beginner Crossrails: Open to riders of any age in their first year of showing over fences, riders may cross enter into Pleasure Horse or Pony and Walk-trot-canter. Classes are judged on the riders equitation and simple changes are allowed. Fences 18".

Pleasure Horse or Pony: Open to any horse/rider combination showing in divisions other than walk-trot.

Short/Long Stirrup: Open to junior or amateur riders in their first 2 years of showing over fences. Fences 2' with no oxers.

Hopeful Hunter: Open to all riders, fences 2' or 2'6".

Pre-Child/Adult: Open to junior or amateur riders, fences 2'3" or 2'6".

Child/Adult: Open to junior or amateur riders, fences 2'9"

Equitation Cup: Open to junior or amateur riders with fence heights offered at 2', 2'3", 2'6" or 2'9". Course will contain bending lines, roll backs, trot jump, or other elements typically found in equitation courses. There is a flat phase following the over fences phase with each phase counting for 50% of the total score.

Hunter Derby: Open to all riders with fence heights offered at 2', 2'3", 2'6" or 2'9". There will be two rounds with the first round being a classic round and the second round being a handy round. The top 12 horse/rider combinations will be invited to return for the handy round and scores from each round will be combined. Entry fee \$30 and the top 3 finishers will win prize money (to be determined by number of entries).

Jumper Classes: Offered at 2', 2'3", and 2'6", will be run as Table II, 2b.
