Evaluation *(the foundation)*

Everything starts with evaluations and data collection. They identify your child's area of need.



Goals

Goals should directly address each documented area of need.



Supports & Services

Supports and services are based on what your child needs to make meaningful progress on their goals.



Placement

The IEP team decides where services can be effectively provided in the Least Restrictive Environment.



Implementation

The IEP is implemented with fidelity by the school team.



Progress Monitoring

Progress must be meaningful, not minimal. If progress is not being made, the plan must be revisited.



Building the Next Chapter

Every IEP should build the skills your child needs for the next chapter in their journey
