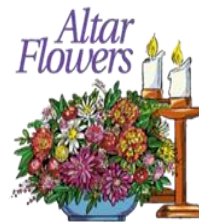
Welcome to Ingleside Methodist Church. We are a community of faith with deep roots in the past, looking to the future.
