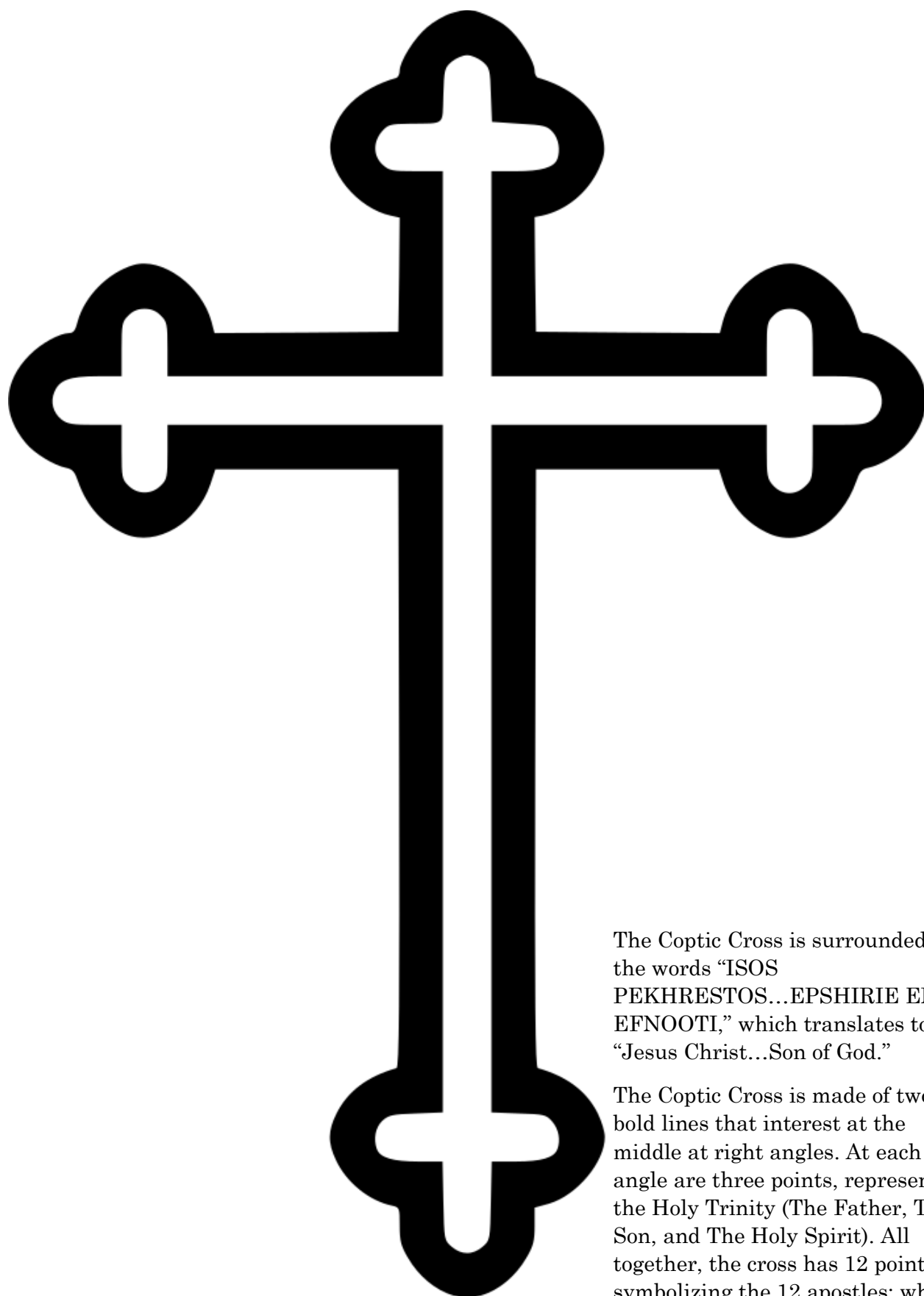


# Coptic Orthodox Christian Coloring Book

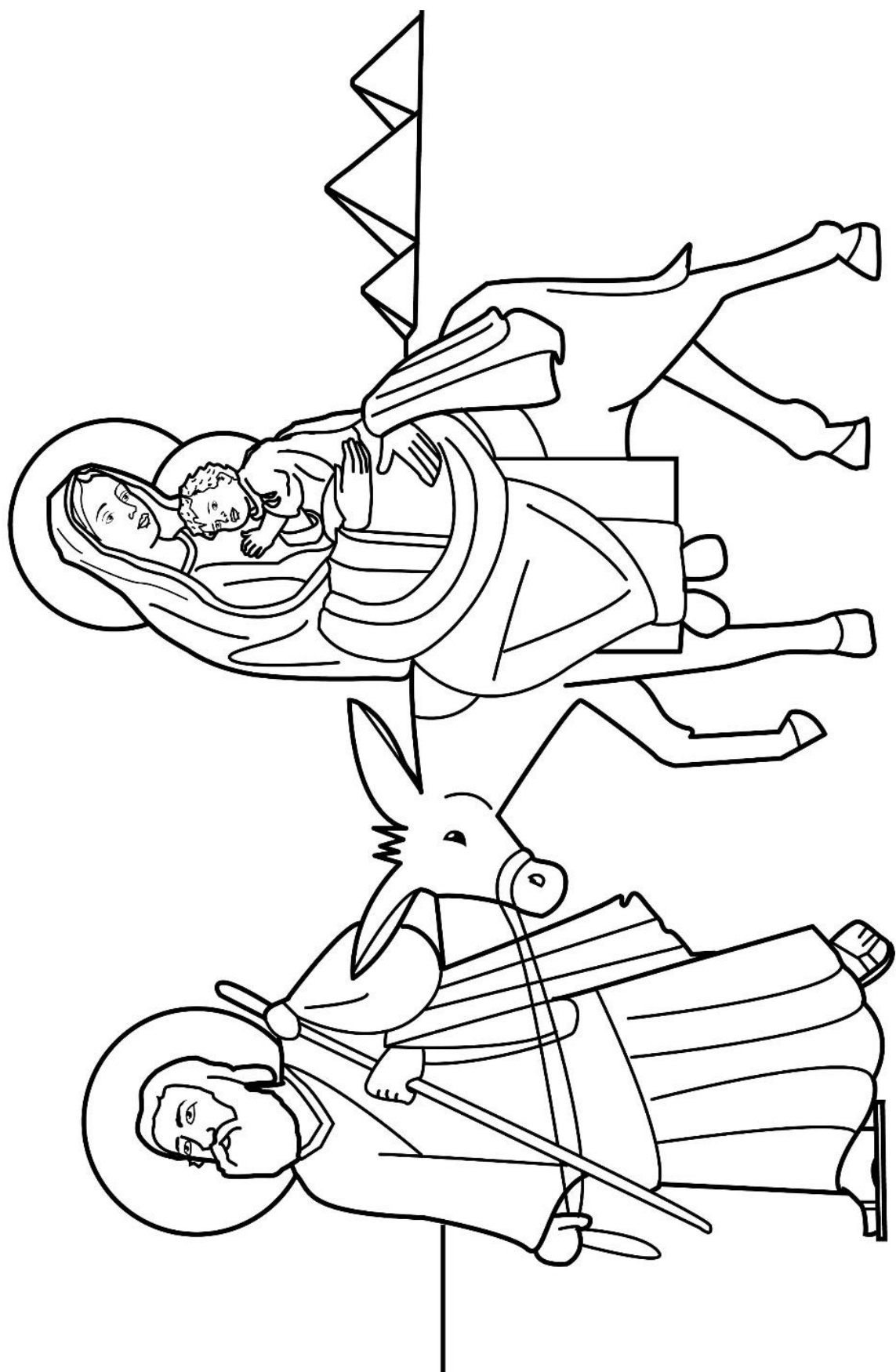

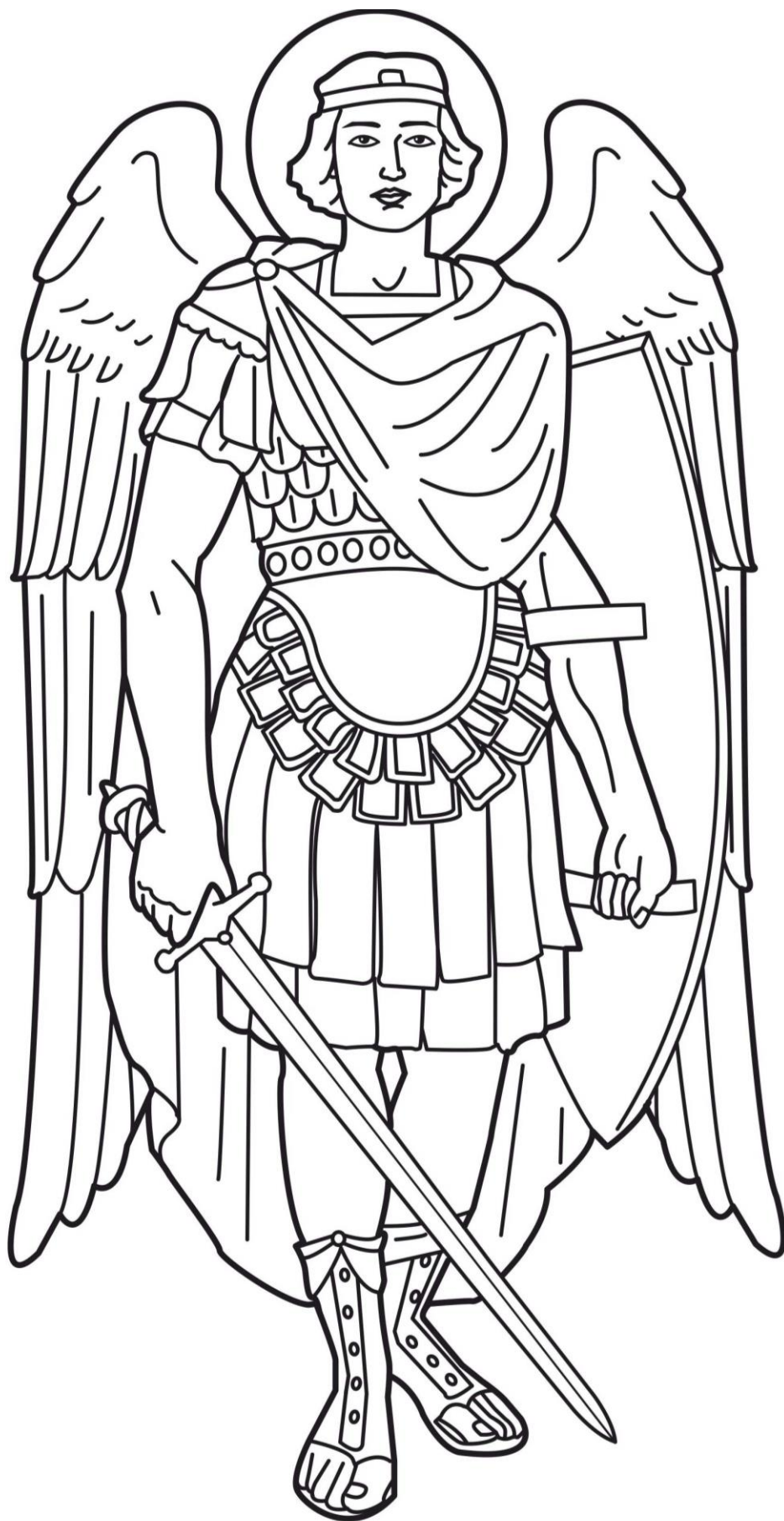
The Coptic Cross is surrounded by the words "ISOS PEKHRESTOS...EPSHIRIE EM EFNOOTI," which translates to "Jesus Christ...Son of God."

The Coptic Cross is made of two bold lines that intersect at the middle at right angles. At each angle are three points, representing the Holy Trinity (The Father, The Son, and The Holy Spirit). All together, the cross has 12 points symbolizing the 12 apostles; whose mission was to preach the Gospel to all ends of the Earth.









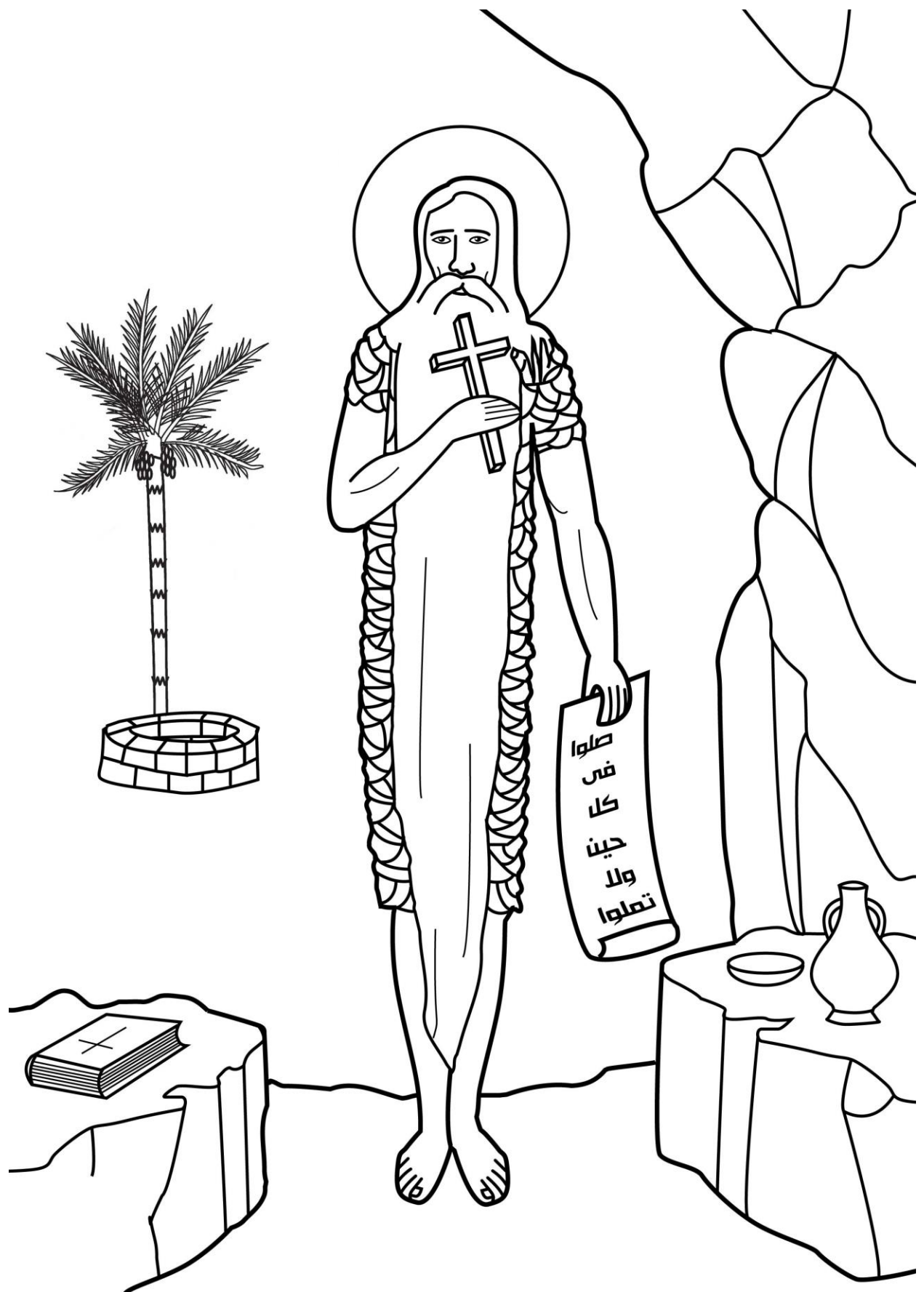
