THE ISSUE

Americans face rising healthcare costs, limited access to providers, and increasing delays caused by insurance-driven barriers.

Too often:

- Patients wait for approvals instead of receiving care
- Providers are burdened by administrative requirements
- The system prioritizes treatment over prevention

LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

Expand Direct Primary Care Access

Support models that allow patients to access primary care more directly and affordably.

Strengthen Preventative Care

Promote early intervention, lifestyle support, and long-term wellness strategies.

Reduce Administrative Burden

Address prior authorization delays and unnecessary insurance restrictions on care.

EXPECTED OUTCOMES

- Increased patient autonomy
- Improved access to primary care
- Reduced delays in treatment
- Greater focus on long-term health outcomes
