More access to care

Expand access to non-VA providers so veterans can get help faster.

Mental health & trauma recovery

Prioritize women veterans

Address the unique needs of women veterans and underserved populations.

Childcare support

Provide childcare vouchers for veterans with 30% or more service-connected disability.

Support student veterans

Partner with colleges and universities to streamline childcare for veterans using the GI Bill.

Protect veterans during licensing exams

Veterans using Vocational Rehab won't lose their housing stipend after graduation while studying for required board exams.

They can check in monthly, show proof of studying, and keep receiving support until they pass.
