THE ISSUE

American families are navigating increasing uncertainty around food safety, child protection, community security, and institutional transparency.

Key concerns include:

- Lack of clarity in food sourcing and labeling
- Rising risks of online exploitation and trafficking
- Community safety challenges
- Erosion of public trust in government accountability

LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

American Food Safety & Transparency Act

Increase transparency in food labeling and strengthen safety standards so families can make informed choices.

Children's Protection & Anti-Trafficking Act

Enhance protections against child exploitation, with a focus on prevention, enforcement, and victim support.

Community Safety & Border Stabilization Act

Promote safer communities through improved coordination, enforcement, and stability-focused policies.

Government Accountability & Transparency Resolution

Increase oversight, transparency, and public access to ensure government systems serve the people.

EXPECTED OUTCOMES

- Improved consumer confidence in food safety
- Stronger protections for children
- Safer and more stable communities
- Increased trust in public institutions

Introduce a comprehensive safety-focused legislative package addressing food transparency, child protection, community safety, and government accountability.
