A TOUGH ACT TO FOLLOW: BLUE WATER THEATRE COMPANY

Rice Street between Broadway Avenue and Walker Avenue in Wayzata is a busy place. That's where you will find city hall, the fire department, the department of motor vehicles, the Wayzata Library, and St. Bartholomew Catholic Church and School.

And then there is a building on the corner directly across the street from the fire station. It is surrounded by beautiful stonework and landscaping. The structure has stood since the early 1900s when it once was a church. Now it serves a different purpose. It is home to Blue Water Theatre Company which was founded back in 2007. Its vision is to develop a safe, accepting, responsive, and supportive community. It aims to build confidence in young people.

Through the years, Blue Water Theatre Company has tackled some high-profile performances including Les Misérables, Singin' In The Rain, The Wizard of Oz, Little Women, and The Music Man.

While the daily hustle and bustle of Rice Street between Broadway and Walker is seen in plain sight, the magic being made at Wayzata's community theater happens behind the scenes. That's where its young cast of characters rehearse with confidence knowing they will steal the show on opening night.



In recent years, construction improvements along Lake Street have been by land. Now, work has started by sea. Okay, in Lake Minnetonka to be more accurate. The Panoway Lakewalk project is moving full steam ahead along the shores of Wayzata. You probably have noticed a barge, crane and other equipment putting piles into place. Those piles will ultimately support the 1,200-foot lakewalk. The Lakewalk will stretch from the Historic Section Foreman House to the Depot. It includes two lakeside overlook terraces.

WALKING ON WATER: WAYZATA'S NEW LAKEWALK

"It's so exciting to see our residents enjoying the fulfillment of Wayzata's 120-year dream with the beginning of the Lakewalk and docks construction," said Peter Hitch, Wayzata Conservancy Executive Director. "We can soon savor a stroll along the lakeside on the south side of the tracks away from the bustle of Lake Street knowing that our lake's ecology will be restored for all future generations."

The lakeshore has always been the crown jewel of Wayzata. Fortunately for us, the railroad tracks have protected it from development. You see, way back when, it ran closer to the businesses along Lake Street. The sparks and smoke were too much for business owners and they fought to have the tracks moved closer to the water. This new project is more than 10 years of persistence, patience, and planning, but the idea goes back further.


The Lakewalk Plan of the Wayzata Improvement Association presented an idea that was led by local businessman Gerry Carisch. The lakewalk was to embody Wayzata's vitality, warmth, and civic pride. Some thirty years later, the concept is a reality.

"We are thrilled to announce that the Carisches and Roths have just committed over \$1M in lead gifts to The Wayzata Conservancy so that we can celebrate the repurposing of the lakefront for hosting public events, bringing friends and family members together, and encouraging people to visit and enjoy downtown Wayzata," said Hitch.

If you're tracking this project, it will work west to east from the Depot down the shoreline. Substantial completion is targeted for May of 2024. A dedication will follow. Until now, the only way to enjoy the Wayzata shoreline was by boat or on ice. Imagine walking down the shoreline with waves lapping at the walkway, a summer breeze blowing, and one of those picture perfect sunsets on the horizon. You won't have to imagine this too much longer. Another way to enjoy the crown jewel of Wayzata.

WAYZATA HISTORY

Once upon a time, there was a hospital located on Lake Street in Wayzata directly across the street from the Depot. Nearly 100 years ago (1928), Minnetonka Hospital opened. It certainly didn't look like the hospitals of today. It was more like a home, because it actually was a house. See, in their second year of business, Dr. Carl J. Martinson and Dr. Edward E. Mitchell actually bought the home from another doctor, Dr. J.J. Tibbitts (Wayzata's first health officer).

CARING FOR COMMUNITY: MINNETONKA HOSPITAL

Let's back up for a minute. Why did Martinson and Mitchell settle on Wayzata? Neither was from the area. Turns out Martinson fell in love with the town back in 1914 during a steamboat ride on Lake Minnetonka. Martinson's wife served as office manager. And Mitchell came into the mix as he was one of Martinson's classmates.

Surgeries took place on the first floor while the second floor housed patient rooms. How did the patients get upstairs? Staff carried them up the main staircase on a stretcher of course. The hospital had 15 beds in six rooms. More than 1,500 babies were delivered at Minnetonka Hospital during its 35 years in business! And who knows how many simple surgeries, bone sets, and stitches.

In the early years, lab services were done in house. In the mid-40s, a clinic on Wayzata Boulevard handled it. Pathologies were shipped off to Swedish Hospital in Minneapolis. It costs \$2.50 per day for room and board. Nurses worked 10-hour days and were paid \$5 per day. We all know how hospital food can be hit and miss. That wasn't the case at Minnetonka Hospital. It was known for its wonderful home-cooked meals. Word likely spread fast because the hospital served the entire Lake Minnetonka area.

In 1948, Dr. Martinson's son Elmer followed in his father's footsteps. He had served as an Air Force medical doctor while in England during World War II. He received training back in Minnesota at Minneapolis General, the University of Minnesota, and at Hennepin County's hospital.

The last baby to be born at the hospital was Rueben Schomer. That was 1963, the final year of the hospital's operation. On December 31 of that year, the final patient, Joanne Wormley, was released from the hospital. In May of the following year, the building was demolished.


