

New Zealand Alcohol Interlock Programme Guide

| Action | Result | Consequence |
|--------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|------------------------------------------|----------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Initial Breath Test Passed: Result is less than 100 µg/l BrAC | PASS | You have 3 minutes to start the vehicle. |
| Initial Breath Test Failed: Low BrAC: Result is between 100 - 249 µg/l BrAC | FAIL LOCKOUT of 5 minutes | The vehicle cannot be started. Handset will count down the temporary lockout period. VIOLATION RESET after 5 Failed Tests Note: Lockout of 30 minutes if second or subsequent initial breath test failed. |
| Initial Breath Test Failed: High BrAC: Result is greater than 250 µg/l BrAC | FAIL LOCKOUT of 30 minutes | VIOLATION RESET after 3 Failed Tests (HIGH BrAC) |
| Initial Breath Test Failed: Combination of low BrAC and high BrAC | FAIL | VIOLATION RESET after 5 lockouts (LOW or HIGH BrAC) |
| Retest Requested | | You have 5 minutes to provide a breath sample. |
| Retest Breath Test Passed: Result is less than 100 µg/l BrAC | PASS | You are able to continue your journey. |
| Retest Breath Test Failed: Result equal or greater than 100 µg/l BrAC | FAIL LOCKOUT of 30 minutes | You must turn your vehicle ignition off. Device alarm sounds until ignition is switched off. Handset will count down the temporary lockout period. VIOLATION RESET after 1 Failed Retests |
| Retest Refusal | FAIL | You must turn your vehicle ignition off. Device alarm sounds until ignition is switched off. VIOLATION RESET after 1 Retest Refusal |
| Starting the vehicle without a breath test | NOT PERMITTED | VIOLATION RESET after 1 Untested Engine Start |
| Power disconnection of greater than 20 minutes For example: disconnecting the vehicle battery | NOT PERMITTED | VIOLATION RESET after 1 Power Disconnection greater than 20 minutes |
| Attempting to circumvent or tamper with device | NOT PERMITTED | VIOLATION RESET after 1 Tampering or Circumvention Event |
| Action resulting in VIOLATION RESET | VIOLATION RESET SERVICE IN 7 DAYS | The vehicle must be taken to the service centre within 7 days for an early service. Failure to service Interlock within 7 days will result in a permanent DEVICE LOCKOUT . |
| Failure to service Interlock when requested | DEVICE LOCKOUT | Permanent lockout until Interlock is serviced. The vehicle must be towed or a Service Unlock Code must be requested. |

REMEMBER: If you keep within the set parameters and provide breath tests when requested, you will not find yourself in any lockout situations and no violations will be recorded.

Provide a breath sample into mouthpiece using correct breath pattern (BLOW-SUCK). | Temporary Lockout 29:55 | The Interlock is temporarily locked out because of a failed breath test / retest. Wait for the countdown timer (mm:ss) to finish. |
| Retest required Please blow | Retest is required. Provide a breath sample into mouthpiece using correct breath pattern (BLOW-SUCK). | VIOLATION RESET | Too many violations have been detected. Contact your Service Centre. |
| Test Passed 0000 µg/l | You have passed the breath test. You can start your vehicle. | Check cable and reconnect ! | No connection between the handset and control box. Check the curly cord cable and reconnect to the handset and control box. |
| Test Failed 100 µg/l | You have failed the breath test. The Interlock has detected alcohol in the breath sample. The vehicle will not start. | Service required in x days | Your scheduled service of the Interlock is due in x days. Contact your Service Centre to confirm your appointment. |
| Free start time: 02:35 | The time remaining (mm:ss) when the vehicle can be started without another breath test. | Service required today ! | Your scheduled service of the Interlock is due today. Contact your Service Centre. |
| Blow longer ! Repeat Test OK | The breath sample was too short. Press OK to start the breath test again, blowing longer. | Device Lockout in x days | The Interlock will lockout in x days. This message means you are past your original service date. Contact your Service Centre. |
| Blow softer ! Repeat Test OK | The breath sample was too hard. Press OK to start the breath test again, blowing softer. | Device Lockout today ! | The Interlock will lockout at midnight today. You MUST have the Interlock serviced today. Contact your Service Centre. |
| Suck after Blow Repeat Test OK | The suck back was incorrect. Press OK to start the breath test again. The suck back is short, sharp and directly after the blow. | Device Lockout | The Interlock is in permanent lockout. You cannot start the vehicle until the Interlock is serviced. Contact your Service Centre. |

REMEMBER: DO NOT eat, consume alcohol, use alcohol-based products (such as mouthwash) or smoke for 15 minutes before using the Interlock as this may result in a VIOLATION.

Note: It is recommended to rinse the mouth with water before providing a breath test.
