- Deuteronomy 6:6-7 "These commandments ... are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road."
- Psalm 145:4 "One generation shall commend your works to another, and shall declare your mighty acts."
- Titus 2:3–5 Older men and women are called to teach, train, and model GODly living for the younger.

Jacob (Israel)	Widower (implied)	Genesis 35:19–20	Life continues though sorrow remains.
David	Widower (implied)	2 Samuel 6:23; 1 Kings 1:1–4	Earthly loss does not end God's plan.
Job's wife	Widow (later implied)	Job 42:17	Suffering and loss remind us of life's fragility.

- 1 Chronicles 17:16 "Who am I, O Lord God, and what is mine house, that thou hast brought me hitherto?"

Serving the Lord as a Household

Key Scriptures:

Joshua 24:15 – "...but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord."

Joshua declares that his whole household will remain faithful to God.

What Is My House?

Household Salvation

Key Scriptures:

- Acts 16:31 "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house."
- Acts 16:33–34 "...and was baptized, he and all his, straightway... believing in God with all his house."

The Philippian jailer and his whole household came to faith together.

What Is My House?

Blessings on the Righteous Household

- Proverbs 3:33 "The curse of the Lord is in the house of the wicked: but he blesseth the habitation of the just."
- Psalm 112:1-2 "Blessed is the man that feareth the Lord... His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed."
- Proverbs 24:3–4 "Through wisdom is an house builded; and by understanding it is established: And by knowledge shall the chambers be filled with all precious and pleasant riches."

What Is My House?

Household Order

- 1 Timothy 3:4–5 "One that ruleth well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity..."
- 1 Timothy 5:8 "But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel."

What Is My House?

Generational Blessings

- Genesis 18:19 "For I know him, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the Lord..."
- Psalm 127:3–5 "Lo, children are an heritage of the Lord: and the fruit of the womb is his reward."

Summary

Your house in the Bible represents your family, household, and descendants. God calls us to **humility** (recognizing His blessings), **faithfulness** (serving Him as a family), and **responsibility** (leading and providing). In return, **He promises blessing**, **salvation**, and **generational favor** for those who walk in His ways.
