

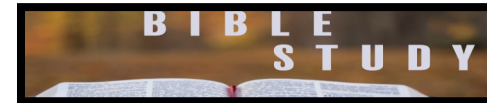

I. Remember, God Is in Control:

- When our nation elects leaders, Remember, God is in control (Romans 13:1-5).
- When people no longer will listen to sound doctrine, Remember, God is in control (2 Timothy 4:3).
- When people persecute us, Remember, God is in control (2 Timothy 3:12-17). When people insult and speak evil against us, Remember, God is in control (Matthew 5:11).
- When we cannot save ourselves from our sins, Remember, God is in control (Acts 2:38; Romans 6:1-7; 20-23).
- When death is near, Remember, God is in control (1 Corinthians 15:54-58).
- Finally, when Jesus returns, Remember, God is in control (1 Thessalonians 4:16-18). We must remember that God is in control and there is none like him (Isaiah 46:9-10).

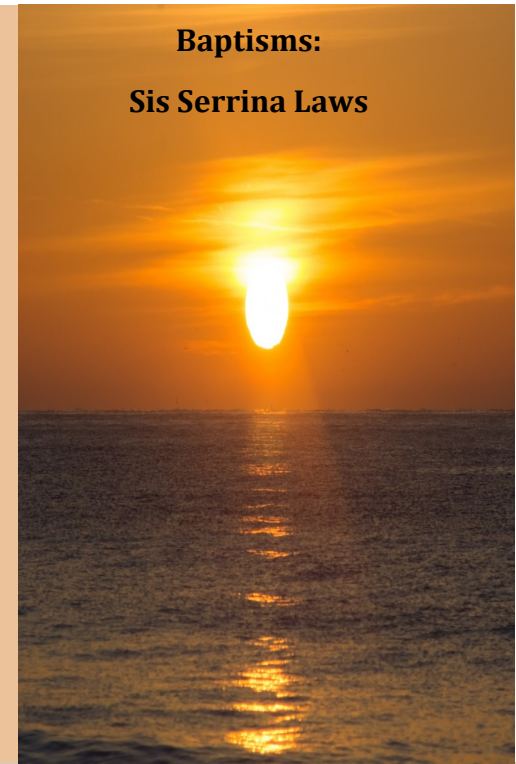
