While you are welcome to come into the court, if you do not feel safe traveling or coming into the court, please email us at parkerjustice@courts.az.gov or fax 928-669-2915 to see if you can be rescheduled or if we can do the appearance in another manner-see below information for Initial Appearances:

Civil Traffic matters-

- You can plead not responsible and request a Traffic Hearing by email or fax.

Misdemeanor Criminal or Criminal Traffic Matter, excluding DUI's, related Domestic Violence, and cases with no alleged victim(s)-

- You can plead not guilty by mail/email/fax. You MUST include a clear copy of your Driver's License. You will be set up for a telephonic Pretrial Conference in about a month.
- If you advise the Court that you want to plead guilty by mail/email/fax. A packet with further instructions for a Telephonic Guilty plea hearing will be sent to you, otherwise, the court will advise you if your presence is mandatory.

Civil filings-

- Forms can be found on our webpage under the "Forms" tab. Once you are ready to file, you can mail or email the forms to the Court. The filing fee can be paid at www.parkerjusticepayments.com.

Protection/Harassment Orders-

- Petitions can be completed at <https://azpoint.azcourts.gov/>. Once completed, you will need to contact the court to get a time to come in and see the Judge.
- If you are contesting a Protection/Harassment order, you can mail/email/fax your request, the court will then notify you of a hearing date.
