From now until April 30th, 2020, many procedures may be done by phone/email/fax to help promote social distancing and reduce the spread of the virus.

While you are welcome to come into the court, if you do not feel safe traveling or coming into the court please email us at parkerjustice@courts.az.gov or fax 928-669-2915 to see if you can be rescheduled or if we can do the appearance in another manner– also see the below information for initial appearances:

If you have a civil traffic matter –

- You can plead not responsible and request a traffic hearing by email or fax.

If you have a misdemeanor criminal or criminal traffic matter, and it is not for a DUI or related to domestic violence and there is not an alleged victim –

- You can plead not responsible by mail/email/fax. Include a readable copy of your driver's license. You will be set up for a pretrial conference in about a month.
- You can advise that you want to plead guilty by mail/email/fax. You will either receive a form for a telephonic guilty plea or you will receive an email advising that you must appear.

For Civil filings, you can get the forms you need by clicking on the forms link on our webpage. You can mail or email the forms back to us instead of bringing them in. You can pay your filing fee at www.parkerjusticepayments.com

For protection Orders, please complete the forms at <https://azpoint.azcourts.gov/> , then call the court to get a time to come in and see the judge or set for a hearing.
