Ranch Rules

- Arrival time is 1:00 p.m. on the initial day and departure time is on or before 11:00 a.m. on your last day (unless other arrangements have been made).
- Hunters and guest <u>must</u> sign a "Release of Liability Forms" and pay balance on hunting package deposit fees upon arrival. Cash, cashier's check, money orders, corporate checks (Payable: Madison Family Land and Cattle), ACH or credit cards are accepted. You may pay your fees online when you book your hunt once you have received an invoice.
- A 2% fee will be added to any payments made with a credit card.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed in hunting areas or while hunting.
- No smoking inside our facilities or hunting area.
- Please help us keep our ranch beautiful and place all trash in containers.
- No pets allowed.
- No hunting boots allowed in the lodge.
- Hunters/guest shall provide their own safety harnesses and lanyards if tree stand hunting.
- Hunters/guest assumes all responsibility for their own safety included stand inspection, climbing in and out of hunting stands.
- The Ranch reserves the right to independently determine if all hunters are properly skilled in the use of firearms before agreeing to allow them to hunt on the ranch. All weapons will be properly stored at all times.
- Intoxicated individuals will not be allowed to hunt or occupy the ranch, and we reserve the right to terminate an individual's hunt or access for cause at any time.
- The Ranch does not discriminate against individuals due to race, color, or religious affiliation. Guests are expected to respect the rights of others or they will be asked to leave.
- The Ranch promotes the humane treatment of animals and will not tolerate unnecessary violence or disrespect to the culture of responsible hunting practices.
- All guests must respect local regulations, including burn bans, and must park vehicles in designated parking areas.
- All guests must have a valid driver's license and automobile insurance in order to be allowed
 to use ranch vehicles. Children under the age of 18 will not be allowed to use ranch vehicles
 under any circumstance.

*Notice: Dangerous conditions, risks and hazards do exist on the ranch, included but not limited to; poisonous snakes, insects, spiders, blinds, tree stands, wild animals, rough, hazardous driving and walking conditions.
