BY-LAW AMENDMENT

Council officers have discussed two options regarding our existing Relief Fund. Presently the fund authorizes \$500 to assist fellow knights, with a maximum single payout of \$250. In light of a recent event, proposal (1) would increase the fund to \$1,500, with maximum single payout of \$1,500. Proposal (2) would remove the Relief Fund from the by-laws and would be replaced by a line item in the annual budget. Advantages and disadvantages of either proposal will be discussed at our September business meeting.

PRO LIFE-CI-128

A very hot topic needless to say. Our three bishops have issued a letter that was provided to all parishes. If you have not seen it, a copy of it will be available at our September business meeting on the 12th. This initiative is on the upcoming ballot and being pushed-primarily by political groups from outside our state. The Initiative removes most existing restrictions to allow an abortion. A new Social Advocacy organization through Montana Catholic Conference is now in place, with this entity to use social media and other sources to educate voters of the dangers of CI-128. Individual contributions to aid our effort are

most welcome. News of the new entity will be detailed in a new letter from our bishops soon.discussion will be a change from \$250 to \$500 for expenditures no needing council approval.
