Preparing for installation day

- Get plenty of rest
- Hydrate
- Wash hair 2-3 days prior to installation date
- Hair should be free of leave in conditioners, oils, grease
- Hair should be in natural state, no blow outs (how God made you)
- Consider cutting excess split ends
- Wear comfortable clothes/socks
- Consider support stockings to reduce risk of blood clots
- Bring snacks/ food/water
- Pillow for back or to sit on

Day of installation

- 1/2 deposit needed to bk installation dates. 2nd 1/2 due day of install: Via: Cash, Zelle, Cash app. or Credit Card.
- Try to keep head straight and facing forward at all times
- Talking is kept to a minimum (focused on installation pattern)
- No REFUNDS once service is started
- No face time
- Please call to reschedule if feeling ill

After installation

- Wear a silk cap @ night
- Wash hair every 2 wks-Bundle hair with rubber bands & only use the Sister Loc shampoo
- Wear a shower cap when showering
- No swimming reccom. for 1st 6 months
- No hair coloring until hair is locd
- No conditioners, oils, grease
- Drink a min. 640z of water a day/daily multivitamin
- Itchy scalp?-spray rose water or sea breeze needed (spray sparingly to scalp)
- Continue to follow-up with loctician every 4 wks until locs are settled
- Additional charge for retie 6wks or greater
- 15 min grace period given for appts, tardiness > 15 min with result in auto cancellation
- Take pics and journal your journey (you'll thank me later)
- Wear a head band when working out, helps keep locs along hairline intact.

General FAQ for Beginners

Q: What is Sisterlocks (SL)?

A: SL is a **natural hair management system** that creates tiny style-able locs. It allows women with tightly textured hair to take advantage of a wide range of today's hairstyles without having to alter the natural texture of their hair or add any products or heat.

Hairstyle **involves creating small/uniform-sized locs**, using a specific locking technique. This technique is often called the "interlocking method," where the hair is woven together using a small tool designed by Dr Cornwell (the inventor of SL).

These locs are typically **smaller than traditional** locs & can be styled in a variety of ways, as they are light weight, versatile, low maintenance, and unique to every individual.

SL is unique to our culture bc you **must have a curl pattern to have the locs** installed & stay in place. They have gained popularity over the yrs. for their unique & appealing aesthetic.

Q: Do I need to have 'fine' hair for Sisterlocks to work?

A: Not at all! In fact, the coarse, thick 'nappy' hair is best for SL. Your natural abundant texture adds body & makes styling easier.

Q: Will Sisterlocks cause my hair to break or thin?

A: Just the opposite! SL is a gentle technique that requires no chemicals, no excessive tightening, & causes no damaging abrasion to the hair or scalp. You will find that with regular care, your locs will grow and grow, and your styling options will increase.

Q: Can I do the locs myself?

A: This is not advised. Not all hair types require the same locking technique. Your hair care professional is the best trained to give you locks that will be best suited for you.
