3. What to Expect

At times the animals have been through unimaginable treatment, including being abandoned by their families, neglected, and abused. Most likely they are fearful, stressed, stressed, and/or in shock. We do not always know much about the dog's history. They may not have known kindness. Please be patient. With kindness and patience they flourish and try to do the best they can.

The first two weeks tend to be the most difficult. You need to be mentally prepared to see some/all of the below situations. It will take patience and at times problem-solving. Let us know what is going on so we can help. You are not in this alone.

The following are some initial things to expect when you bring in a foster dog:

- o No formal house-training (pooping and peeing indoors)
- o Vomiting
- o Worms in the stool
- o Recovering with scabs and stitches (post-op)
- o Finding ticks (likely dead)
- o Resource guarding (toys, food, humans)
- o Separation anxiety
- o Lack of crate training
- o Leash-pulling
- o Barking (at other dogs/humans/unknown items, at nothing, demand barking)



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- Fearful of things: Stairs, gardeners, strangers, vacuum, skateboarders, traffic, larger dogs, smaller dogs, men, the opposite sex, going outside, leashes, etc.
- Conflict with family animals:
 - Family dog/foster dog getting in a fight (that you must be prepared to break up)
 - Chasing cats inside the home (cat-dog compatibility to be discussed)
- Wanting to bolt out the door, as soon as you open it! (keep leash on while inside house!),
- Eating out of the bathroom trash can (paper products)
- Breaking out of their crate
- Scratching at the crate tray (Is that crate tray secure? Use zip ties!)
- Unknown illness
- Touch sensitivity (Do not pull on a dog's collar. Always use a leash to redirect/move them)

- I understand that GTR does not know the history, human interaction or animal interaction of the dog I am willingly bringing into my home.
- As a foster care provider, I understand and agree to adhere to all relevant zoning and animal control codes and ordinances, whether local, county, or state.
