#### 2. Commitment

We require at least a 1-2 month commitment for our foster dogs, unless a different time frame was already discussed. The average length for a dog to find their forever home is 1 month.

#### 3. What to Expect

At times the animals have been through unimaginable treatment, including being abandoned by their families, neglected, and abused. Most likely they are fearful, stressed, stressed, and/or in shock. We do not always know much about the dog's history. They may not have known kindness. Please be patient. With kindness and patience they flourish and try to do the best they can.

The first two weeks tend to be the most difficult. You need to be mentally prepared to see some/all of the below situations. It will take patience and at times problem-solving. Let us know what is going on so we can help. You are not in this alone.

The following are some initial things to expect when you bring in a foster dog:

- No formal house-training (pooping and peeing indoors)
- Vomiting
- Worms in the stool
- Recovering with scabs and stitches (post-op)
- Finding ticks (likely dead)
- Resource guarding (toys, food, humans)
- Separation anxiety
- Lack of crate training
- Leash-pulling
- o Barking (at other dogs/humans/unknown items, at nothing, demand barking)
