We have worked closely with key partners including UMOS, MATC, Associated Bank, Froedtert Health System, American Family, and WHEDA to provide businesses access to Workforce Development Opportunities, Access to Capital, Culturally Relevant Technical Assistance during the Pandemic and Advocacy for bilingual services.

Our accomplishments in 2019-2020 include:

- 1st Latino Economic Unsummit with over 200 participants and twenty-two partners.
- Implementation of our Emergency Service Hotline serving 607 business callers.
- Assisted 27 businesses through our Cash Flow technical assistance sessions with North Shore Bank.
- Launched our Microloan Program Mas Fuertes, lending \$75,000 to enterprises adversely affected by COVID-19.
- Partnered with Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation to process 243 applications for the Governor' Ethnically Diverse Emergency Grant.
- Partnered with the City of Milwaukee to promote, provide technical assistance and support to 50 businesses with the Restart 2.0 Grant.
- Provided OSHA10 Training, Blueprint Reading, and Computer Skills for businesses and their employees.
- Conducted 17 virtual seminars assisting businesses with Federal, State and Local Resources and Health Orders issued during the pandemic. Each Seminar reached an average of 1.1k hits on Social Media.
- Advocated for translation of health orders, grant applications, and other communications in Spanish.
- Gave away 500 masks in partnership with 16th Street Clinic.
- Fundraised \$140,000 in resources to deploy to help adversely affected businesses during COVID-19.
- Our Hispanic Heritage Series was featured in CBS58 and attracted thousands of individuals who viewed it.
