THIS MONTH IN CLASS

Religion - We continue to reflect in our Scripture Booklets on the New Testament. We looked at the mission of Jesus and also the world Jesus lived in. We then studied the Gospel stories of the Nativity of the Lord, watched a movie and reflected on the experiences of Mary and Joseph in trusting God. Language Arts - Our literacy unit focuses on "Who am I?". Students are finishing self-descriptions based on several reflection opportunities. These will be combined with art facial sketches in a presentation form.

Socials – We have been looking at the start of agriculture, considering different hypotheses. We combined our learning with a study of mythology and the students are writing their own myths on how farming began.

Science – We are looking at various ways that electricity is generated and transported to us, and the students will research sustainable electricity alternatives.

Math – We finished our introduction to algebra and have been looking at how we use integers in our lives, as well as math operations with positive and negative integers.

Sports – Our boys and girls volleyball teams ended their season and now we are raring to go with basketball. Go Celtics!
