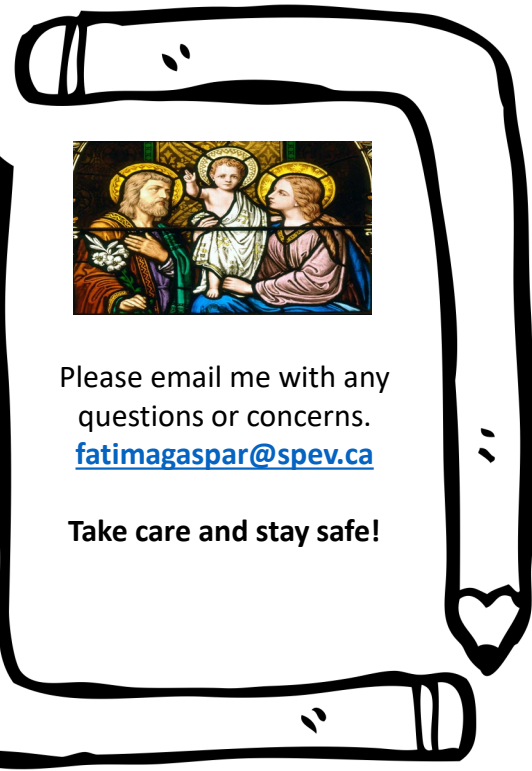
- Please check & initial planners daily
