A few things that are essential to your child's learning this year:

- **Homework Folder:** This folder will their agenda, notices, and any other important information or materials. They will go home every day and come back to school every morning. Please feel free to use their folder from Kindergarten if they are still in good condition. Otherwise, I kindly ask that you replace it for this school year. It must be large enough to fit a duotang in and must have a zipper or something to seal the bag (a large plastic Ziploc bag works well too).

- **Placemats**: Since students eat at their desks for both snack and lunch, I would like to ask you to buy one PLASTIC placemat that will be left at school. You can find these at the Dollarstore.
- **Music Mats**: Mrs. Prescilla is our music teacher and she has asked that every student in the school brings a small fabric mat that they can sit on while in the music room. This is due to the health and safety of the all classes that she sees throughout her days.
- **Reading Logs**: The Home-Reading program will be starting very soon and all students are required to participate as it builds their literacy and communicative skills. You and your child are to read together every night for 15 minutes. I will not be sending books home, however we will be using a program called Epic!, which is an online resource where I assign books to your child. The next morning, I will check that they have read their book through the online system. Each time your child reads 15 books, they will receive a sticker from me! I have provided instructions on how to sign in on the last page of this newsletter.
- **SeeSaw**: I am currently working on setting this up for your children. I am excited for you to watch your child grow academically and see what they are doing in class! I intend to post once a week and your child will post something themselves once every two weeks (sometimes more depending on the week).
- **Physical Education (PE)**: PE will be on **Tuesday** and **Wednesday** afternoon. Students will arrive to school already dressed in their PE uniform and will stay in this uniform for the entire day.
- **Outdoor Recess**: The children will be playing outside for recess rain or shine. As the upcoming months get cold and wet, please ensure that your child arrives in appropriate weather attire.

I am looking forward to getting to know you and your family. Good communication between parent, teacher, and student is very important for your child's academic growth and also creates a positive community that St. Patrick's Elementary continues to have!
