IMPORTANT INFORMATION

I'm a Gift from God program

This Spring we will be implementing an Archdiocesan-approved program on the prevention of child sexual abuse. The program is designed for children at the primary level. We will be using the program in Kindergarten to Grade Three. Until recently, sexual abuse was a crime rarely discussed with children. Our own parents may have given us vague warnings about "strangers", but few of us received any specific information on sexual abuse or methods to protect ourselves. Research has shown that children who have been informed about this crime are less likely to be victimized. We believe that children can and need to be safeguarded. We educate our children regarding many aspects of growth and development such as bike, traffic, water and poison safety.

The focus of this program, I'm a Gift from God, is the prevention of sexual abuse. Children will learn ways to say "no" and whom to tell if an incident occurs.

EMERGENCY SCHOOL CLOSURE (reference SPEV Parent Handbook pg. 29)

Severe weather or other emergency situations such as loss of hydro power, interrupted water supply or heating system breakdown may force school closure. If a decision to close the school is made prior to 8:30 a.m., it will be broadcasted over the local radio station CKNW - AM 980 and Z95.3 – FM 95.3 as early as possible. Parents are also advised to check the school website www.spev.ca and refer to the Remind app.

OUTDOOR CLOTHING

Parents are expected to ensure that their children dress appropriately for the weather conditions. As the students are frequently involved in outdoor activities, they need to arrive to school in a warm water-repellent hooded jacket or coat. Gloves or mittens and boots are essential in cooler weather. If it is designated as an 'outdoor day', all students will be sent outside.
