OUR MONTHLY LEARNING FOCUS

Math: Review counting forward, backward make 10, doubles and near doubles strategies from term one, and fact families from before the break.

Language: Writing sentences using proper grammar. Students are encouraged to read from a variety of book types (fiction, nonfiction, educational magazines, cartoon, and chapter books)

Science: We are working on our Forces and Motion unit this month. Our buzz words are: Position (location of an object), Push and Pull. Students will be asked to bring in a toy that moves or has moving parts this month (date TBD).
