Brain-based research shows that these kinds of activities provide rich opportunities for the brain to develop problem-solving mechanisms. It will be great if your child can spend these times with friends to further develop their social skills. **School reopens on March 28<sup>th</sup> 2022.**

**Read at home:** Please continue to read as many library books as you can with your child during the break. It will be beneficial for you to read a bedtime story to your child every night and end each day with a talk about what went well during the day and what he/she can do to "have an even better day tomorrow."
