<b>PANTS:</b>	REGULATION CHARCOAL DRESS PANTS
<b>BLOUSE:</b>	REGULATION WHITE PRIMARY – POLO SHIRT INTERMEDIATE – OXFORD SHIRT **Centennial Polo (Spirit Wear) for 2022-23 school year only.
<b>SOCKS:</b>	REGULATION GREEN COLOUR (same as the sweater), GreenKnee Highs, ankle socks or tights. (Not Pantyhose)
<b>SHOES:</b>	ALL BLACK IN COLOUR. Low cut, dress, casual or running shoes. (NO PLATFORM SHOES - 1½ inch heel max).

Gym strip will be worn throughout the day on scheduled PE days. Students may wear Spirit Wear Sweat Suits over their PE Strip to stay warm. This will be considered part of the uniform and no other clothing will be acceptable.

**SHORTS:** REGULATION SCHOOL GREEN from Neat Uniforms

### OTHER FEES for 2024-2025:

<b>General Fee</b>	\$150.00 per student due upon acceptance and non-refundable. This fee covers expenses related to copying class resources, paper, student resource textbooks, student consumable workbooks, class resource fees, agendas, art, music and gym equipment and other essential resources.
<b>Emergency Prep Fee</b>	\$40.00 For all new students Kinder through 7; and all returning Grade 4 students
<b>School Supplies</b>	\$50.00 per student due upon acceptance and non-refundable. This fee covers expenses related to student consumable supplies. To save costs these items are purchased in bulk & kept at school for students use.
<b>Fundraising</b>	\$150 minimum per family
<b>Parent Participation</b>	40 hours which is equivalent to \$30/hour; Non-Participation Fee is \$1,200/per year.
