Tuesday, September 6: Doors to the school will open at 8:40 a.m.

We will continue with the Drive Thru morning drop off only. Please remember to drive slowly 10km per hour or less, this means your foot should always be on the brake pedal. Drive all the way to the front of the line so we can fit more cars in the stopping area. For student safety, students ideally should be seated on the right side of the car. Staff will assist if your car is set for child lock. The gate will open at 8:30 a.m. More information can be found on the school website.

Students who walk or take transit can enter the school via the gate on Quebec Street at 8:30 a.m. or use the pedestrian walkway that has been marked with cones. Please remember that this is for students only and will open at 8:30 a.m. Families that arrive earlier than 8:30 a.m. are to stay with their children as there is no staff supervision.

The doors to the school will open at 8:40 a.m. Students will then be directed to go straight to their classrooms after sanitizing their hands.

Staff will be outside to assist all new students.

We will no longer be using the after school drive thru process. Instead, please park your car, pick up your children, meet the staff and if you have some extra time socialize with each other.

COVID-19 Update

- Our Communicable Disease Prevention Plan which focusses on reducing the risk of transmission of communicable diseases (including COVID-19) will be readily available on the school website.
- We will continue to regularly clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces which can help prevent the spread of communicable diseases.
- When weather permits, windows will remain open.
- We will facilitate regular opportunities for hand hygiene including sanitizing hands when entering and leaving school.
- Staff, other adults entering the school, parents, caregivers, and students should not come to school if they are sick and unable to participate fully in routine activities. It is encouraged to continue completing daily health check which should be done prior to arrival at school.
- The decision to wear a mask is now a personal choice based on individual preference as it is no longer recommended by public health. Students and staff who choose to continue wearing a non-medical mask or personal prevention measure will have their choice respected.
