Dear Parents of St. Patrick Elementary School,

I am taking this opportunity to recap the regular requirements pertaining to the different categories of placement of students within our Catholic School System.

I reiterate them, regarding Category 1:

DANCE WORKSHOP

Students have been asked to wear their gym strips on October 12. For October 13, students may come to school in their costumes or their school uniform, but not their gym strips.

Traditionally in First Nations dancing, costumes must compliment each other. Boys have been asked to wear white, while girls to wear green. Clothing must also be below the knee. In First Nations dancing, the knee is not to be shown.

Girls: dark skirts or dresses with a length below the knee and a green or white top. Boys: black pants and a white top (tshirt or shirt).

Please do not go out and purchase items. Students may wear their school uniform if they don't have the required items. For safety, students will wear runners during the performance.

Parents are invited to watch our dance in the gym on Thursday, October 13 at 1:45 p.m. Doors to the gym will open at 1:40 p.m.

We are pleased to announce we have teamed up with **MunchaLunch.com** as our online ordering system provider to restart our school's hot lunch program! To start off, we have Pizza Tuesdays with Pizza Hut and Pirate Pack Thursdays with Whitespot! We hope to expand and bring in more vendors in the near future and a survey will be sent out later to see what the other food options parents would like to see made available at the school.

Currently, we only accept hot lunch order payments by credit card (Visa or MasterCard). It's quick and easy to pay online, and only requires your cc number, exp date, and cvc. No cheque or cash payments will be accepted at any time.

HOW TO REGISTER:

- 1) Go to: https://munchalunch.com/schools/stpatricksvan
- 2) Click the "Register Here" button. The system will guide you through.
- 3) After adding your children, click the green "Order Lunch!" button to order
- 4) Next time, just click the "Login Here" button to access your account.

Please note: first-time parent registrants must use this link which will direct you to the St. Patrick's Elementary School's dedicated landing page (ie. you cannot go directly to the MunchaLunch website as the registration link is not listed there).



ORDERING DETAILS:

- Online ordering will be OPEN on Monday, October 18, 2022 and will close on at midnight one week before the delivery day.
- Hot lunches are offered on scheduled Tuesday and Thursdays in the month. Term 1 hot lunches run from October 25, 2022 to December 3, 2022. Term 2 hot lunches will start after the Christmas holidays (TBA)
- Please ensure that you have PAID for all orders, as this system will NOT include UNPAID orders to our reports.
