\*<u>Social Studies:</u> contour lines & geographical features; latitude/ longitude

\*<u>Religion:</u> God as the Trinity; the Church as an assembly

\*<u>Language Arts</u>: reading different stories and learning various strategies; Book Club; writing a short story with characters, setting and problem/ solution

\*French: Basic greetings and vocabulary on Les Animaux
