(DRsABCDE), Severe Bleeding - Tourniquet (TQ), Wound Packing, Partial / Full Amputations, Severe Burns, Choking, Penetrating Chest Wound. CPR - Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation. Embedded Objects - With or Without Exit Wound. Abdominal Injury. Crush Injuries. Hyperthermia / Hypothermia / Frostbite Shock. Drowning/Near Drowning. Seizures. Snakes, Funnel Web Spiders, Blue Ringed Octopus and Cone Shell. Other Bites/Stings (e.g. Bees, Wasps, Spiders, Ants, Jelly Fish, Ticks), Cane Toads, Allergic Reaction / Anaphylactic Shock, Dental Problems. Poisoning (Baiting, ingested chemicals etc.) Strains and Sprains. Smoke Inhalation / Carbon Monoxide. Electrocution and so much more...
