

Pre-Treatment & Aftercare Brow Tattooing

Thank you

Firstly, thank you for selecting me to do your treatment.

On the day

My studio is located in PRIMROSE BEAUTY - 51 STONECOT HILL, SUTTON, SM3 9HJ.

On the day of your appointment, please come on time, but not too early. As we don't have a receptionist to let you in, and I will likely be tattooing.

Can I bring a friend?

I am happy for you to bring a friend or family member, but bear in mind, my studio room is small, and we need to be respectful of other salon users.

What about parking / public transport?

I recommend you park in Asda, Stonecot hill. Or in the surrounding streets. Both are free for 2 hours.

From Morden or Wimbledon station you can get a 93 bus directly to the studio. The stop is Ash Road.

How long will my appointment take?

You will be with me around 2 hours. So please leave plenty of time.

What payment methods do you take?

You can pay by cash or card on the day.

From 2025 a £50 deposit will be taken on booking. Details below.

This is refundable should you cancel 48 hours before the treatment.

Any cancellations after this will result in a loss of the deposit.

Will it be painful?

Any type of tattooing is painful. I recommend buying numbing cream online and applying 45 min before your appointment in a thick layer.

Brands I recommend are TKTX, totally numb or emla. These can all be bough online without prescription.

Sadly, I cannot provide numbing creams as it is illegal to supply in my council borough.

Legal Things

- For brows, you require a patch test for your treatment. Please do this as soon as it arrives.
- If you have any illnesses, skin conditions or take under regular medication, please let me know prior to booking.
- I am unable to tattoo those under active chemotherapy or who have had surgery to the site 6 months prior.
- I cannot also accept patients with DBS or pacemakers.
- I cannot accept patients who have autoimmune disorders including Lupus.

Pre-treatment Instructions

- 1. Keep skin well moisturised on the run up to your appointment. Skin that is dry, flaky or irritated will take pigment poorly.
- 2. Stop retinols as soon as you book and avoid for 4 weeks post treatment.
- 3. Do not pluck, wax, dye or perform electrolysis on the tattooing site for 7 days prior to the appointment.
- 4. Do not sunbathe, self-tan or burn skin for 7 days prior to the appointment.
- 5. Avoid blood thinning agents prior to your appointment, these including fish oils, vitamin C, ibuprofen and aspirin. If you take blood thinners for a medical reason, please let me know when booking.

Aftercare

After the tattoo, you should expect some redness and oozing. This is a healing response and can last for 24 hours.

I will provide a clean tissue on leaving and I would like you to dab the tattoo if they ooze on the way home.

I will also provide a vitamin balm, which I like you apply twice daily.

Washing the brows twice daily with a gentle soap, will prevent infection and aid healing. Washing does not remove pigment, but it will reduce your chance of a nasty infection.

Erythema around the tattoo in the first 24 hours is normal. But new erythema at 48-72 hours is a sign of infection.

Scabbing and flaking are normal, and fading between appointments is expected. This is why you will have 2 sessions with me to complete the brows

Please avoid the following

- No swimming, sauna and steam rooms for 2-3 weeks.
- No excessive sweating for 72 hours.
- No picking of the brows
- Please avoid retinols, glycolic acids and vitamin c in the healing phase. These all affect retention of the pigment.
