





#### **STORY**

Foster the Village is a tax-exempt, 501c3 organization that supports children from birth to 18 years old in Brown County who have been removed from their homes and placed in foster care due to abuse and/or neglect. We brighten the lives of children in out-ofhome care by providing essential basic needs and community support, to ease the foster care journey for children and caregivers.

We know that when basic needs are met, it can reduce the stressors that lead to abuse and/or neglect.


#### **OUR IMPACTFUL**

#### **SERVICES**

We provide free basic needs items such as clothing, shoes, baby gear, seasonal boots/coats, diapers, bedding and larger items such as car seats, cribs and high chairs. These supplies help ensure a smooth transition and a comfortable environment for children and the foster families that open their hearts and homes to them.

We also offer training and support for foster parents and social and emotional learning sessions for the children placed with them. Our space allows for a safe environment for children and families to feel welcome and supported.

- 3 Special Family Events hosted

- 36 car seats purchased and provided to foster families to keep children safe (\$6,000 value)
