I just received notification from Mike Ingram, NCRS National President, on behalf of the NCRS **Board, that the National Convention has been cancelled.** The following is the summary of his letter. "In light of the ongoing coronavirus pandemic and the evolving guidance from the CDC, federal, state, and local authorities. the NCRS Board of Directors has decided to cancel the 2020 Convention planned for July 19-23. The health and wellbeing of the NCRS membership was foremost in our mind as we made this decision.

Refunds will be made to those who have already registered. The French Lick Resort has already, or will shortly Issue a blanket cancellation of reservations made in the NCRS block." "We are strongly recommending that all NCRS Chapters continue to follow CDC, federal, state, and local guidance until the coronavirus pandemic is behind us. At a minimum, we suggest that you cancel any events planned between now and the end of the Convention blackout period, which would have run through August 6, 2020. Mike Ingram on behalf of the NCRS Board"

Brad and I had not realized the far-reaching effects of the Coronavirus. Our continued good health is the main priority at this point.

This will certainly be a great time to work on those corvette projects.
