Blast 2019" Judging Event
October 18-19, 2019. The Gathering Room @ McCoy's
Council Bluffs, IA
Our fall chapter judging event will be here soon and it is looking to be a fun and informative weekend. Planning has been going on for 3 months to make this a great event for both long time NCRS Members as well as brand new ones. No matter your Corvette knowledge level, this will be an event that you won't want to miss. We will begin our day on Friday at 3:00pm with Registration and Operations Judging. For those of you not judging, you can join us and get your registration packet anywhere between 36pm. We have 4 great Corvettes lined up for judging: 1960, 1966, 1967 \& 1968. Operations
Judging covers all the functions of the Corvette from headlight operation to back up lights and everything in between. We will then move all 4 Corvettes into the building and get them
staged for judging on Saturday. At 5 we will have the first of our two judging schools for the weekend. The judging school should wrap up around 6:15 and then we will have a social hour followed by dinner served right on the judging floor sitting among the Corvettes! Dinner should be finished by 8ish and our day is done.
Saturday morning, we open registration at 8am and will jump right into our second judging school. The judging school will start at 8:30 and be finished by 9:15. There will be a short owners meeting and we will dive right into judging our 4 Corvettes. This is where the real learning and understanding of the NCRS System happens. I want to stress how much a brand new NCRS member can learn from being a part of the judging process. We have what is called "Observer Judges" or OJ's. Even if you have never judged before, I encourage you to sign up and get involved as an OJ for both Friday and Saturday! You can choose to stay on one car and OJ several sections, or work around from car to car. The judging usually takes several hours, and we will break at 12 for lunch. Following lunch, we will get back to finish
up final judging, get the score sheets tabulated and then we will have the final awards presentation. If all goes as planned, we will be finished and be ready to take the Corvettes out of the building by 2:30. We are lucky to have two National 400+ point NCRS Master Judges that will be presenting Judging Schools that they only give at regional and national conventions. Gary Bosselman is presenting "Engine Stamp Pads \& Broach Marks" how it was done at the factory, on Friday afternoon. Dave Houlihan will be presenting "Flight Judging: A 10,000-foot Owners Perspective" on Saturday morning. Both schools will be extremely informative for both experienced judges as well as new NCRS Members.
Socializing and getting to know other NCRS Members better is part of what NCRS is all about and for that reason we have planned Friday night dinner \& Saturday lunch right on the judging floor. You will have a chance to get to know other NCRS members in a casual atmosphere. I am hoping that you will be able to join us for the meals.

The registration cost for the two day event is $\mathbf{\$ 2 0}$ and $\$ 25$ for meals on both days. So $\mathbf{\$ 4 5}$ for registration covers everything. Please use the registration form and mail to Brad Hillhouse, Judging Chairman ASAP so we can get a final count for the event. We have NCRS Members joining us from 7 states and Canada, I would really like to have great attendance from our Nebraska Chapter as hosts of this event.
