Crocus Bag Relay Rules

Objective:

Teams race to complete a course by hopping in a sack, tagging the next teammate, and having them continue the relay.

Equipment:

- 1 crocus bag per team
- Each team consists of 4 members
- Cones or markers for turning points

Setup:

- Each team lines up behind the start line.
- The first player from each team stands inside the sack, holding it up around their waist.

How to Play:

- 1. At the signal (whistle, shout, etc.), the first players hop to the turnaround point, and back.
- 2. Upon return, they hand the sack to the next teammate.
- 3. The next teammate gets into the sack and repeats the process.
- 4. This continues until all teammates have completed the course.
- 5. The first team to have all players finish wins.

Basic Rules:

• Players must stay inside the sack the whole time.

- Hopping is required, running while holding the sack is not allowed.
- If a player falls, they must get up without removing the sack.
- Teams may be disqualified or penalized for cheating (e.g., taking off the sack, running instead of hopping).
- The event official has the right to disqualify a team at their discretion.
