Easy Card Wallet

A great use for charm squares... this also works as a scrap buster!

The outside of the card holder is 5" x 6". The remaining 3 fabrics are 5" charm squares.

Fold two of the 5" x 5" squares in half, **WRONG** sides together. These form the pockets.

Lay the folded squares on right side of the 5" x 6" fabric. Serge or stitch both ends.

Center the last 5" x 5" square on top of the previously stitched fabrics (right sides together). This is an approximate center; it is not precise. The raw edges of this last piece will match up or meet the raw sides of the other fabrics, but it will **NOT** meet the stitched ends. Serge or stitch both sides.

You're done sewing! Now, it's just a matter of turning and pressing. Reach in-between the last piece of fabric and the first three pieces of fabric; turn, as shown.

Then, turn one of the folded squares right-side out. For crisp corners, use a point turner on each corner. Press. (The lining is shown in the photo on the left.)

Repeat for the other folded square. Press.

Insert a gift card (or two), and fold closed. Now you're ready to go with a custom-made present that's not just another gift card!
