## Be prepared to give an answer for the hope within you!

"But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that is in you. Do this with gentleness and respect, keeping a clear conscience, so that those who speak maliciously against your good behavior in Christ may be ashamed of their slander."

If we truly cherish Christ as we live our lives from day to day, people will notice the difference the Lord makes in our attitudes and behaviors. This affords us with excellent opportunities to tell our stories of changed lives, that in Christ, we are NEW creations!
