My goal as a teacher in the classroom was to NEVER embarrass or humiliate a student. Teachers should always encourage students and build their confidence. In all the years that I taught from my Basic, Intermediate, and College Algebra: One Step at a Time books, I placed this verse on a page near the beginning of each book! “Do NOT be afraid” is a major theme of the Bible, applying to many fearful situations—yes, even to MATH!
