Financial Aid Options

1. NC Opportunity Scholarship / ESA+

--Apply online at <https://www.ncseaa.edu/k12/opportunity> for up to \$6,492 per year.

2. START Scholarship – **Limited Availability**

--First-time students are offered a discount on your first year tuition:

One child – 40% discount on tuition

Two children – 45% discount on tuition

Three children – 50% discount on tuition

--No application necessary – First-come, first-serve basis until limit is reached.

3. Legacy Aid

--Complete a third-party financial aid assessment online at <https://sssandtadsfa.force.com/familyportal>. There will be a \$60 application processing fee, collected by TADS. The application process should take approx. 45 minutes. (Application processing fee will be deducted from tuition.)

--Significant discounts available based on financial data submitted.

K12 Programs: Eligibility Requirements Updated for 2023-24

Students must meet the following requirements to be eligible for each program.
Families can apply for both programs.

Opportunity Scholarship

All Required

- Household must meet the Household Income Eligibility Guidelines (students in foster care are automatically eligible regardless of the household income of their foster family)
- At least 5 years old by August 31 or at least 4 by April 16 and approved for kindergarten according to [State guidelines](#)
- Lives in NC
- Has not graduated high school
- Has not enrolled in a post-secondary institution full-time*

One Required

- Received and used Opportunity Scholarship funds in previous year
- Attended a NC public school or Department of Defense school in NC as a full-time student**
- Entering kindergarten, 1st grade, or 2nd grade
- In foster care, or adopted within the last year
- Has a parent on full-time active military duty, or a parent who received an honorable discharge within the last year

ESA+

All Required:

- Is a child with a disability who requires special education, as documented by a NC public school IEP Eligibility Determination
 - At least 5 years old by August 31 or at least 4 by April 16 and approved for kindergarten according to [State guidelines](#)
 - Lives in NC
 - Has not graduated from high school
 - Has not enrolled in a post-secondary institution full-time*
 - Eligible to attend public school in NC
- Students who meet the criteria outlined above and have one of the following designated as the primary or secondary disability on the IEP Eligibility Determination may be eligible for a higher scholarship award than full-time students without these designated disabilities.

Terms listed in parentheses as they appear on the Eligibility Determination:

- Autism (Autism)
- Hearing Impairment (Hearing Impairment, Deafness, Deaf-Blindness)
- Moderate or Severe Intellectual or Developmental Disability (Intellectual Disability, Moderate or Severe)
- Multiple, Permanent Orthopedic Impairments (Orthopedic Impairment)
- Visual Impairment (Visual Impairment, Deaf-Blindness)

*Full-time: 12 or more credit hours in a given semester.

**Attendance in the spring semester prior, or attendance two years prior with private school attendance in between

For both programs, students funded in the prior year receive priority consideration.

Applying for Financial Aid

for the 2023-24 academic year

We partner with TADS in our financial aid process. To begin your financial aid application, you will complete the Parents' Financial Statement (PFS) then submit the required documents for our school indicated below.

The PFS is a comprehensive application that will take some time to complete. Give yourself the time you need by not waiting until our deadline approaches. You'll need your most recent tax return before beginning the PFS.

We will communicate our financial aid decision to you. To make our decision, we use the information from the PFS as a starting point and consider our school policies, practices, and available budget.

How to complete your Parents' Financial Statement (PFS) online

- Beginning September 1, 2022, go to the Family Portal at <https://sssandtadsfa.force.com/familyportal>.
- Create your Family Portal account with your email address and a password. If you applied for financial aid last year, log into the Family Portal as a Returning Family using your same email address and password.
- Complete a PFS for Academic Year 2023-24. You can log out at any time and return later to finish it.
- When all PFS sections are complete with green checks, the Submit & Pay button activates. Follow prompts to the payment screen. **The \$60 fee is nonrefundable.** Once your PFS is submitted, it cannot be withdrawn from the SSS system.
- After you pay for and submit your PFS, the next step will require you to upload required documents by their deadlines as part of your application process.

How to submit your required documents online

- Prepare your document files for uploading. Make sure the documents are on your computer and each specific form is saved as a separate file. Examples: a) 1 PDF file for the 1040 with all schedules and worksheets included, b) each W2 saved as its own file. Remove any security or password protection from your files.
- Return to your Family Portal account and confirm you are on the Academic Year 2023-24 Dashboard.
- In the "Required Documents" section, use the Upload button or link associated with the specific document type. Follow prompts to locate, select, and confirm the file to upload.
- Click the Submit button to complete your upload. The date will appear in the "Date Uploaded" column within minutes of the upload. Repeat this process until all required documents are submitted by their deadlines.
