From the Pastor's Desk

Greetings in the Name of the Risen Savior Jesus!

Doing church while in the Covid pandemic, epitomizes the saying, "we've never done it this way before"!

First, I want to thank you for your prayers. I also want to ask that you keep the church council in prayer as we navigate our church through new and uncharted waters of change concerning the direction of Immanuel Union Church.

We are in this together, but more than that, God is walking through the fire with all of us, and I believe we will come out the other side victoriously!

We are grateful to God and the way He has sustained IUC for more than a hundred years of service to Westerleigh and beyond. God is so faithful, and the aspect of giving is one of the most puzzling to the world around us, in that when we give, we open ourselves up to the blessings of God in a significant way.

If you are unemployed at this time, we will pray God will either restore the job you had before these challenging days or assist you in finding a better one! God is still a God of miracles and provision!

As you know, if you have attended here for any amount of time, you know that a good portion of our operating budget is sustained through the financial contributions of you, the church body. Not only is this how the church becomes stronger, but we believe it's also how each one of us learns to trust God through our finances!

The plan, at this time, is to begin meeting in person in our sanctuary on Sunday May 2nd. Since May, 2nd is the first Sunday of the month Communion will be celebrated. IUC will provide everyone who would like to celebrate Communion with a Prefilled Communion Cup that includes the Bread & Juice; we will continue to abide by the requirements for a safe gathering. This will include masks (please bring your own); social distancing of 6 ft. apart; we will not use any Bulletins or Hymnals. We will no longer be receiving a public offering during worship but there will be a drop box at the Deacons Station where you can contribute your offering upon entering the sanctuary or as you exit.

As I said these are uncharted waters for us, but I would encourage you to remain faithful in public worship if at all possible. Please consider how God would want you to remain faithful in your giving. This epidemic has financially been a challenge to everyone which ultimately has affected our church budget. Please remain faithful in your giving. We have a variety of ways for people to give, whether it is through drop off at the Church, the U.S. Mail, online, or using an app!

be contactless. Please call the church office for dates or to set up a drop off time.




Flea Market


