From the Pastor's Desk

To All Who May Still be Feeling the Heat,

I wanted to take a moment to send you this note of encouragement as you are going through this challenging time in our lives.

You may be familiar with the account of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego the fiery furnace from the book of Daniel in chapter 3: *Then King Nebuchadnezzar was astonished and rose up in haste. He declared to his counselors, "Did we not cast three men bound into the fire?" They answered and said to the king, "True, O king." He answered and said, "But I see four men unbound, walking in the midst of the fire, and they are not hurt; and the appearance of the fourth is like a son of the gods."*

As the powerful King Nebuchadnezzar looked into the fire, I believe he had to do a double-take and then another double-take! These three Hebrew nobody's were no longer bound, instead they were walking around in the fiery furnace, fellowshipping with one another in the presence of their God!

They weren't sitting in a corner huddled in fear, nor were they complaining about how hot heat of the flames were. Instead, they were enjoying refreshing fellowship with THE ONE, with the appearance of the "son of the gods." We know better that He wasn't just the "son of the gods" but God the Son, Jesus our Christ! What's most important here, is even this pagan King was able to recognize the King of Kings amid the fiery trial of His people! It's important to remember that the same God that was there for them at that time is here for you and me now!

We may not enjoy hearing this, but I believe that one of the ways the Lord uses to bring us closer to Him and to know Him more, is through trials. We may not know what to do during the trial, but it causes us to focus on His power and not our limitations!

Peter in 1 Peter 1:7 tells us that our trials come from God more often to strengthen us rather than punish us: "so that the tested genuineness of your faith—more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire—may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ. We can't stop the trials from coming, but with God's help, we can adjust our attitude when those trials arrive.

I don't share these words as someone who has not experienced my share of trials. I have, but I wanted you to know that the same God who brought me through them, will do the same for you. Keep your eyes focused on Jesus, who is your "fourth man" in your fiery trials as well. With that hope in mind, I would like to keep you informed of several things happening at IUC:

First, we are having a Church Garage Sale Saturday June 14. I hope to see you all there in person. Second, by God's grace after almost 14 months of online worship we are finally meeting together in person. We are still on Zoom each week as well for those of us who may not be ready to meet in person yet. I am hopeful after a Covid free summer you may be ready to join us for worship in person. We are planning a special time for Rally Day Sunday, which this year is September 12. Finally, we are working on a new look for our Church Lamplighter which we hope to unveil in the September edition. Be on the look-out!!
