Pastor's Letter

To Those Who Hunger to Commune With their Savior,

I was truly glad when in 2009 the church Board unanimously sustained a motion to celebrate the Lord's Supper on the first Sunday of each month.

Communion is an act of deep fellowship with God, with the saints above, and with one another. The Church is the covenant communion of those united to Christ, and we are the recipients of all the benefits and blessings of Jesus Christ.

Communion with God is achieved through Jesus Christ, alone. By our faith in Jesus Christ, we have communion with the triune God. Therefore, when we participate in this meal, we feast and fellowship with God. Our worthiness to sit at the table with God is based on our relationship to Jesus.

By virtue of our union with Christ, we are in communion with all other Christians, even with those who have been glorified (Hebrews 12:22-24). Let the implications of that sink in for a moment: When we partake of Communion we are spiritually feasting with our Lord and the souls of the many believers whose faith has fully been realized as they await for the day of Jesus' return, the time everything will be made right.

When we partake, we are in communion with one another. We share in a common responsibility towards one another (I Corinthians 12:7). Paul, in effect, told the Corinthian Church, "Yes, Corinthians, you've been given extraordinary gifts, but those gifts don't belong to you; they belong to the body. God gave you that gift for the common good. In the same way that he can say in that mystical passage that the husband's body belongs to the wife, and the wife's body belongs to the husband, so also, all of my gifts belong to you, and all of your gifts belong to me, and all of our gifts collectively belong to one another; they are for the common good.

Since we are all members of His body, we need one another to function correctly. Therefore, the questions we should be asking are, is this really manifested at Immanuel? Are our members so intimately connected that we can rightly be called a body?

Do we strengthen, exhort and encourage one another? Have we discovered what it takes to be a part of a healthy body? For example, when my back hurts my entire body is affected. Do we as a body feel the pain caused by the wounds inflicted when members are out of fellowship, or are hurting or grieving?

Pastor's Letter (con't)

Are we so intimately connected that, "If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honored, every part rejoices with it. Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it." (I Cor 12:26-27)

Therefore, receiving Communion one a regular basis should evoke a sense of spiritual unity that should spur us on to a right standing with God as well as one another. It should spur us on to a greater dedication to grow in Christ, engage in ministry, and be obedient to all the duties we are privileged to partake in.

When Communion is properly approached it can be uses as one of the most powerful means of keeping our church peaceful and pure which is a goal that all our members should be striving towards.

Lounge clean-up continues to be a work in progress.
