Pastor's Letter

To All Who Have Been United to Him by His Resurrection,

If someone were to ask, "what do you believe to be the single most important event in history", what would come to mind? The splitting of the atom? The first walk on the moon? The tearing down of the iron curtain? The Pilgrim's landing on Plymouth Rock? How many of us would even consider the resurrection of Jesus Christ?

How many of us consider Jesus' resurrection to be an item of faith rather than historical? A mere story rather than history?

We might be hesitant to give such an answer, lest we be viewed as some religious zealot. Perhaps we want to avoid the controversy that such an answer might launch. But unlike many other historical events that come to mind, the resurrection of Jesus the Christ still has relevance over daily existence.

Most people do not realize that the theme of the Resurrection is actually one of three resurrections that affect believers:

The first is the bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ. His body that was beaten, crucified, and finally placed lifeless in a tomb is the same body that God raised from the dead on the third day.

The second resurrection is the one we experience when we come to faith in Jesus Christ. Paul wrote that God "made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved—and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus." Eph. 2:5b,6. It is this resurrection that transformed Paul. Paul was one of the most knowledgeable men of his day. He was a member of the highly regarded sect of the Pharisees, a Roman citizen and a man who had no equal with regard to his zeal as an effective persecutor of the Church of Jesus Christ. While Paul was on his way to Damascus, he was interrupted by Jesus with a heavenly flash of light and this question, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?" Not long after his arrival in Damascus, this persecutor of the Church was now its greatest defender. This same Saul became Paul, the one who so confidently defended the fact that Jesus was the legitimate risen Messiah. Later in Paul's ministry, he would write that, "For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve." I Cor. 15:3-5. The atoning death and subsequent resurrection of Jesus is the fact deemed by Paul as being "of first importance" because in it, Paul himself had been transformed into a new creation.

Pastor's Letter (con't)

The third resurrection is the one to come. In the Apostle's Creed, we affirm that we believe in "...the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting." Do you just say that by rote or do you really believe that one day your body will rise again?

In the Heidelberg Catechism, the 45th question asks how does Christ's resurrection benefit us? The answer is a summary of what is written above: "First, by his resurrection he has overcome death, so that he might make us share in the righteousness he won for us by his death. Second, by his power we too are already now resurrected to a new life. And third, Christ's resurrection is a guarantee of our glorious resurrection."

It is because of God's gracious hand that Paul was changed, and it is because of God's gracious hand that you and I are changed and brought to new life. This Easter, take delight in the historical truth of the Resurrection. He is risen! He is risen, indeed!

May God bless those who a partakers of His great mercy and know the living hope of the resurrection of Jesus Christ,
