Pastor's Letter

Dear IUC Family and Friends,

We love the church because Jesus loved church. He loved it so much He died for her. Therefore, this letter is for the purpose of letting you know that you are of great value to us and are sorely missed when we are apart. Now that the summer is over, it is my hope that you will be able to attend the public assembling of ourselves in the worship of God. I assure you, if you do you will find His worth far greater than those trivial activities that seem to lure us away from His presence.

Please make a special effort in attending worship on September 15th. On that Sunday we will celebrate a very special person for her ministry to our church. Diane Pillarella has been our pianist since 2004 until relocating to Delaware.

In 2019 when the Covid-19 plague sent NYC into quarantine we began meeting through Zoom. It was then that God laid upon Diane's heart a willingness to fill in the gap by enhancing our Sunday Zoom Worship with her musical as well as vocal talents. Not only did she willingly play she did so freely. This was a time when due to the Covid lockdowns we were barely able to sustain ourselves financially. After returning to in person worship services Diane continued to willingly serve us every Sunday from her Delaware home via Zoom.

Several weeks ago, Diane mentioned to Leslie that she would like to get involved in a church in her area and would continue using her musical talents at IUC through the 15th of September.

The council then decided that we should make her final Sunday a special one. So, after agreeing to play for us in person during our September 15th worship service, we will have a church fellowship out on the church patio area so that we can honor Diane for her many years of selfless service to our church.

I'm asking all of you to please attend in person on that Sunday in order to celebrate Diane's many years of service to us all. Food will be provided. Therefore, all you need to provide is yourself with a glad heart.

There are a couple of other events I'd like to mention to you: On September 21st IUC will sponsor another vendor fair. We need your participation in helping to make this a success. We need sandwiches as well as baked goods.
