### Pastor's Letter

New Year's Greetings to All!

As we embark upon a New Year, once again we find that we are still dealing with this Pandemic in America. However, as you know, the entire world is going through the same.

I don't know about you, but perhaps there was a sense of hope last year at this time that as we closed out 2020, this would all be behind us within a few months. We were looking forward with certainty that we would be returning to permanent in person worship, but that's not the case, despite everyone's best efforts of wearing masks, boosting the vaccine whose promise was to be the cure it in just two doses, as well as the seemingly arbitrary mandates in each state. We find ourselves beginning 2022, after a short season of in person worship, returning to at home worship until further notice.

The Council met at the end of December to discuss the current Covid situation. Due to the severe spread that's occurring, it was decided to stop meeting in person, meet only on Zoom weekly through the end of February.
