From the Pastor's Desk

To those who love Jesus and also love Immanuel Union Church, greetings to all of you and I pray that you are all doing well. We are now 6 months into being at home and not meeting in person for Church-I really miss you all! It's been a hard 6 months. As it's been hard for all of us individually, it's also been a big struggle for our Church. Financially things have been much more of a struggle since everything at Church came to a screeching halt- no Church services, no rentals, no fundraisers, absolutely nothing!

Well, the good news is that we all have a big opportunity to see each other in person and also serve at a fundraiser for our Church. On October 17th, Immanuel is having a GIGANTIC OUTDOOR BOOK SALE. A great big shout out of thanks goes to Bunny Matthius, who selflessly has spent countless hours organizing the books, and she even brought Barbara out to sort paperbacks! She says there must be over 5000 books!

Novels, kids books, cookbooks, Christian books, magazines, CD's and DVD's- there's a TON of every type of book that you could possibly want. However, as you all can imagine, in these current days of Covid, having any kind of a sale bringing people together takes more thought, and much more planning. We are in challenging times.

So.... here's the plan. We will set up an outdoor book fair spreading from the Church corner near Jewett, all the way up Maine Avenue to the next corner, and then around the corner and to the back on Ohio place toward the patio. So what is it we need from you?

First, let me say that if you are in the vulnerable risk group for Covid, we are asking you to pray in your homes for us on that day. Pray for God to keep everyone safe, for people to come out and buy books and for it to be a prosperous day for Immanuel.

For those who are able to come out and safely volunteer outdoors (we will be socially distanced and everyone will be wearing masks) we are asking you for your help. We need everyone we can possibly get to be spread along the book route and assist shoppers. We will have a few cashiers along the book line, so that we can keep people flowing safely. WE NEED YOU! Set up will begin at 8 a.m. on Saturday. (If you wake up and it's raining, the rain date is the 24th). We need men to assist and guide the scouts with set up.

The sale officially begins at 10 a.m. and closes at 3. If you can volunteer, we look forward to seeing you. Please call the church number 718-448-1584 and leave a message or let Gina know you will be volunteering.
