#### THE WORD OF THE LORD

AS GIVEN TO ME IN

JANUARY 2025



While praying in the Spirit, only speaking English here and there, the LORD began to deal with me concerning a few things (of course). I rested in the experience, silencing myself to hear what He might say. As I opened my mouth to pray in English (perhaps seven words), I heard the LORD say, "the 7 Spirits of the Lord." Immediately, I went to my Bible, both the physical book and the app, wanting to pray with accuracy. The text I needed was already highlighted, but instead of praying, I read, led by the Spirit, starting from the bottom of the page.

"He will make a highway for the remnant of His people, the remnant coming from Assyria, just as He did for Israel long ago when they returned from Egypt." *Isaiah 11:16 NLT* 

A profound weight settled upon me, a heaviness in my spirit, as I pondered this. I skipped up the page, and the message became even more profound.

"Then at last the jealousy between Israel and Judah will end. They will not be rivals anymore." Isaiah 11:13 NLT

"Oh my," I thought, "that's the church." I continued reading.

"In that day the Lord will reach out his hand a second time to bring back the remnant of his people—those who remain in Assyria and northern Egypt; in southern Egypt, Ethiopia, and Elam; in Babylonia, Hamath, and all the distant coastlands." Isaiah 11:11 NLT

I read verses 6 through 9. Then, moving to the beginning of the chapter:

#### A BRANCH FROM DAVID'S LINE

was the title that introduced Chapter 11 of Isaiah. Immediately I thought, "He is the vine, I am the branch. As the vine, He is my source of life, my source of strength." A wave of tranquility washed over me, filling me with an almost tangible strength. So, I knew that I must go to that text and see what the LORD was pressing me to seek after and experience.

"Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing."

John 15:5 NLT

Then the LORD revealed the connection between this chapter and Isaiah 11.

references, John 15, John 16, John 17.

I also knew that I could not leave John 15
without seeing what was in John 16 that the
LORD was saying, and it was a lot. Then, the Holy
Spirit reminded me of the next chapter, John 17, where
Jesus prays for the disciples and all those who would become.
I spoke, "Oh this is good. God, You are so faithful." So, I wrote all three

A sense of understanding washed over me. "Ok," I declared, "this is what you're doing! So, let's GO!" I knew He would provide more details later, and until the LORD provided clarity, I continued to type above:

John 15 John 16 John 17

The LORD spoke, "See what happens next." So, I flipped over and pressed the icon to skip over to Isaiah 12. Immediately I was reminded of Chapter 12, or more so it became very familiar. It was as if this was a conversation I have had before. As I looked over the text, I considered, "This is a song. We will definitely create this song." However, as I began to read it, the LORD gently corrected me: "No, it is a song. I instructed you to write it." I looked closer and noticed the strategic color patterns with the highlights. I sat in silence.

The Lord then impressed upon me the importance of context: "You cannot see what happens after without seeing what happened before." He led me back to Isaiah 10...

"Go again"
...then to 9...
"Stop there."

Each chapter resonated with its own impact on me as I read it. Isaiah 9 stirred within me a sense of urgency, a call to be ready. Isaiah 10 brought a deeper understanding of the spiritual battles we face. Isaiah 11 filled me with hope and empowered me, and Isaiah 12 was an assurance of God's faithfulness. A thought crossed my mind: "Is this for each year or something?" Counting the chapters, I realized it spanned four years:

- Isaiah 9 2025
- Isaiah 10 2026
- Isaiah 11 2027
- Isaiah 12 2028

countered that thought: "Don't count the years! Embrace the seasons. Be instant in season and out of season" (2 Timothy 4:2). These four years represent seasons of spiritual growth and execution. Isaiah 9 is the season of hope and readiness, a call to

repentance, a call to be vigilant. Isaiah 10 is a season of spiritual warfare,

a time to stand firm. Isaiah 11 is a season of outpour, restoration and hope, a promise of God's continued presence & power. Isaiah 12 is a season of celebration and praise, a time to rejoice in His faithfulness.

So, people of God: BE instant in season and out of season (2 Timothy 4:2). This is a revelatory instruction given to Timothy by Paul about preaching – declaring the truth. Preach – a word of war. Be ready to release the truth to power whether it is convenient or inconvenient, expected or unexpected.

#### BE READY.

Ready which means prepared (with an 'ed') if you are preparing now, you are late – catch up. Ready which means available – prepared and equipped. Ready which means willing – mental strength. Preach the word of God. Be prepared, whether the time is favorable or not. Patiently correct, rebuke, and encourage your people with good teaching. For the time has come when people are no longer listening to sound and wholesome teaching. They are following their own desires and are looking for teachers who will tell them whatever their itching ears want to hear. They are rejecting the truth and chasing after myths. But you should keep a clear mind in every situation. Do not be afraid of suffering for the Lord. Work at telling others the Good News and fully carry out the ministry God has given you (2 Timothy 4:2-5). His instructions were clear, and this is what the LORD said concerning those texts:

- Study it.
- Pray it.
- Be it.
- Live it.

Reflecting on this experience, I realized the weight of the task before me. I must prepare the people, but I cannot do so without first being prepared myself.
"So, I questioned, "is this the word of the Lord?" My thought was because if it is, we are behind. If I must prepare the people, then we are behind. What kind of prophet am I if I am receiving this word so late? However, I picked up my phone to begin typing. I wrote, "2025 - The Word of the LORD."
A feeling of self-consciousness arose. "I got the word late this year?" I thought. The enemy wanted me to feel

embarrassment and defeat. But the LORD God immediately reassured me to silence the voice of the enemy and not to worry about what others might think. FOCUS. So, I proceeded.

right word. So, I returned to the scripture; and I noticed "second time" in verse 11. God reminded me: "You prepared the people last year when I gave you 'RESET: Second time, Second Season." For those of you who follow me as I follow Christ, you know that the LORD gave me the word 'RESET' in 2019 before COVID hit. We prepared the people to "RESET: Build your house." The LORD put the emphasis on the house: personal body & heart; the house: family (domestic) body (meaning structure and behavior) and the heart. I asked about the body of Christ, the church. He said, "Obey this, and all else will benefit," including the church.

There is so much more to that word from 2019 for 2020, but I do not want to put the emphasis on what He told me then. However, God wants the emphasis on your consideration of your experiences then. What state were you in before, during, and after COVID? How did you respond in each instance, season? Where were you mentally, spiritually, and emotionally in each instance, season? How was your relationship with the Father? Were you obedient and being who He has called? Had you become relaxed, comfortable, complacent – out of the will of God?

#### Consider it.

Now, understand that in September 2024, the LORD stopped me in the middle of a texting conversation with my husband and said boldly, "RESET." And I texted it to my husband. RESET. A profound sense of urgency gripped us, so much so that we immediately abandoned a business deal we were actively discussing in the text thread, a deal for which the contract had just arrived that day. The intensity of the 2019 experience was upon me once more. I had that same powerful surge I felt back in 2019 concerning what was coming in 2020. However, the urgency was greater this time. The impact was greater. In 2019, "RESET" was a nudge, a forceful call to re-evaluate. In 2024, it was a clarion call, a trumpet blast demanding immediate attention – a shaking. The weight of the world, the urgency of the hour, was palpable. So, I did not wait to prepare the people – I spoke it immediately.

That night at midnight, I released the Word to the people of God, and from that day and each day remaining in 2024, I continued to speak it and declared the things God said to do 'NOW' because this is how we will PREPARE for what would happen soon, starting next year – soon. I remember hearing the Spirit of the LORD speaking through me as I said, "I do not know if it will happen

in January, and if it doesn't (the Spirit rushed in and said) 'DO NOT get relaxed. IT SHALL HAPPEN in 2025. Revival shall fall. THIS revival will not look like the revival the church has prayed for; not the revival the media team at your church has advertised with a flyer. THIS will be a Hebrew 12 revival." I was led by the Spirit of the



Living God to persuade the people to read, study, pray, repeat Hebrew 12, 1 Corinthians 12.

- Read it.
- Understand it.
- · Apply it.

So, people of God, understand that this Word, that which you are reading, hearing or watching, is not a Word of preparation. This is a Word of ACTION. RESPONSE. 2024 was the year of DIVINE ORDER. DIVINE ALIGNMENT. We were to prepare then. So, now, again, if you are not prepared – CATCH UP.

HURRY UP.

RUSH like the mighty Ruach of God, which means execute in POWER, LOVE, and SOUNDNESS. Meaning there is no time for insane believers, no double-mindedness in the hearts of the saints. We have a work to do that has already started. It is not about to be in 2025. It has begun. We ARE the work that God is working. So here is the assignment to the church, the Body of Christ. Take heed.

Read Isaiah 11 in the New Living Translation:


## The Word of the LORD: BRING BACK THE REMNANT (NLT)

This word resonates with a depth far beyond simply "preparing" the remnant. "Bring back" is a powerful command—an order to resurrect and resuscitate—to revive from unconsciousness or apparent death. It speaks of a restoration so profound it exemplifies the very breath of life as in a "formed man out of dust with no life" and then "ADONAI ELOHIM BREATHED" (Genesis 2:7). It speaks of a restoration so profound it exemplifies the very breath of life spoken from a weeping, deeply troubled, interceding YESHUA (Jesus) who thunderously ordered "Lazarus come out" and out came the man who had ONCE been dead (John 11:43).

"And it shall come to pass in that day, that the Lord shall set his hand again the second time to recover the remnant of his people, which shall be left, from Assyria..."

Isaiah 11:11 KJV

It wasn't until I returned to the text and read it in the King James Version that I fully grasped the significance of what The LORD had prepared us for, starting in September 2024, with "RESET." The Lord shall set His hand AGAIN the SECOND TIME to recover the remnant of His people.





# The Word of the LORD: RECOVER THE REMNANT (KJV)

Recover? Yes, recover. This is not just about returning to a previous state. It's about reclaiming what was lost, restoring what was broken, and revitalizing what was dormant. 2020 was the chance to do it. But did you?

Were you a part of the remnant who RECOVERED then? Did you return to the normal (the God ordained) state of health, heart, mind, and strength of the LORD?

OR

Did you press the RESET button on the life prior to THE HAND OF THE LORD STRETCHING OUT? Did you ignore the warning – the call for the remnant?

These are crucial questions for each of us. Have we truly allowed God to recover every part of our being, or have we backslid and then clung to old patterns, old wounds, old ways of thinking? Are you so comfortable in your current state that you've forgotten the pain, scent, and appearance of bondage? Does Egypt feels, smells, and looks that good to you? – RESET. For real.

"Then it will happen on that day that the Lord WILL AGAIN ACQUIRE with His hand a second time The remnant of His people, who will remain, From Assyria..." Isaiah 11:11 AMP From the Amplified Version, the LORD asked me, "Who Will Remain?" I did not answer, because, of course, I did not know. But I do know that God's questions are actually statements, because He does not ask seeking information. He is the information. Omniscient, He is. He is all-knowing. These questions are a challenge, a call to examine your heart. Will you be among those who remain faithful, who endure, who are found worthy?

The Word of the LORD: WHO WILL REMAIN? (AMP)

The Word of the LORD: ACQUIRE AGAIN (AMP)

He is obtaining again for Himself a people who desire Him, who are operating in obedience. He is actively seeking those whose hearts are fully His –

The "seek ye first" crew, those who prioritize His kingdom above all else. He is obtaining them, again (Matthew 6:33).

# The Word of the LORD: REDEEMING OUR TIME (TLV)

After this, I was thinking, then I said aloud, "Father, I know this is enough versions of the Bible, right?" Quickly He said, "SEEK." I smiled and said, "Yes, Sir." Even when we think we have reached the limit, God's instruction remains: SEEK. There is always more to discover, more to know, more to understand. I mean, why ask if it is enough? If it was, He would have said it. So, I continued.

"It will also come about in that day that my Lord will again redeem—a second time with His hand—the remnant of His people who remain from Assyria, from Egypt, from Pathros, from Cush, Elam, Shinar, Hamath, and from the islands of the sea." *Isaiah 11:11 TLV*That was the Tree of Life Version. I kept seeking; now, of course, I was scrolling.

"At that time the Lord will use his power again to recover what remains of his people in Assyria, Upper and Lower Egypt, Sudan, Elam, Babylonia, Hamath, and the islands of the sea." Isaiah 11:11 GW

This is the God's Word version.

#### GOD's WORD: THIS YEAR GOD WILL USE HIS POWER!! - AGAIN?

I hesitated to type "again," even though it is written in this version just like the others. I had not hesitated with any other version. I paused because "again" can imply "like before." But with this particular version of the text, the LORD wanted me to understand that we will see His POWER MOVE in ways we have not ever seen before! This is not a repeat of past moves of God. This is a new wave, a fresh outpouring, an unprecedented display of His power. But if it is something we have not seen before, why is "AGAIN?" emphasized? Again, of course, means another time, once more, but it also means: "in addition to what has already been mentioned." Already been mentioned: prophesy, prophesies. What God has spoken, He has already seen and experienced. That is the reason we have to take His word—believe it or not, seek Him concerning it or not, respond to it or not – and ACT suddenly because it is guaranteed. His word is not contingent on our acceptance It is truth, regardless of our response.

These instructions are from the heart, mouth, and hand of GOD, confirmation drawn directly from the prophetic word spoken in Isaiah 9-12, revealed in John 15-17 and IS manifesting in, through and for us, IN THIS DAY. The instructions provide a framework for engaging with these powerful passages, but they are not an exhaustive exegesis. To fully understand and apply these truthful instructions, it is essential for each of you to read and meditate on both passages within each section, seeking the Holy Spirit for personal revelation and guidance. This is not simply an intellectual exercise; it is a call to active obedience, a journey of believing, receiving, and operating in God's transformative power. The instructions below set the backdrop for your personal study and experience of these texts.

Our response, then, is fourfold, a powerful synergy of engaging with God's Word and living out its transformative power:

### Study it - Stay Connected (Isaiah 9 & John 15)



Immerse yourselves in His Word (Isaiah 9 – Study it), diligently seeking its meaning and allowing it to take root in your hearts. Remember, this is your personal study. Ask the Holy Spirit to illuminate the text for you. This study fuels your connection with Him, grounding you in His love and truth (John 15 – Stay Connected). This is the foundation, the place where you learn and grow in your relationship with the Vine.

### Pray it - Transform (Isaiah 10 & John 16)

Cultivate a deep and consistent connection with Him through prayer (Isaiah 10 – Pray it), bringing your needs, your desires, and your very selves before Him. Prayer is not just a ritual; it is a conversation with your Creator. Communicating what you know from study, and allowing the Holy Spirit to pray through you, pour out your heart to Him – the heart that has WORD hidden in it. Through prayer, you open yourselves to His transforming power. His transforming power joins power with the Holy Ghost power that is rushing in you and the WORD of God that is now breathing through you, collectively causing you to be molded, again, into His image (John 16 – Transform). Prayer is the catalyst for change; the place where you surrender and receive His transforming grace.

# Be it - Transition (Isaiah 11 & John 16)

As you are transformed by His Word and prayer, you are called to be the change you have received (Isaiah 11 – Be it). This is a call to embody the truths you are learning. This inward transformation naturally leads to an outward transition—a supernatural shift in your actions, your behaviors, and your very way of life (John 16 – Transition: Shift). Being it and transitioning are two sides of the same coin; as you become more like Him, your life supernaturally shifts into that change.

#### Live it - Intercede (Isaiah 12 & John 17)

Live out this transforming prophecy in practical, tangible ways, demonstrating your faith through your actions (Isaiah 12 – Live it). It is manifesting through you, His people. This life of active faith, exemplified through celebratory worship (Isaiah 12 – Live it), is sustained by constant intercession (John 17 – Intercede). It is through intercession that obedience and purpose are infused into the lives of others as you speak what God has said for their lives into their lives. Intercession is the fuel that keeps you going, the power source for a life lived in obedience and purpose, impacting not only your own life but the lives of those around you. Let intercession be your constant companion, empowering you to live out your faith boldly.
