Application for Annual Registration Certification for Private Sewage Contractor/Pumper

Pursuant to the Christian County Private Sewage Ordinance, all Private Sewage Contractors and Pump

ers in operation within the Christian County boundaries are required to obtain a Certificate of Registration from the Christian County Health Department (a State license from the Illinois Department of Public Health is also required).

This Department shall issue a certificate to persons applying for such a certificate who comply with the minimum performance standards set forth in the Ordinance, and who pay the required annual registration fee (\$125.00 per each licensed installer/pumper and \$20 database maintenance fee.). <u>ATTENTION SEPTIC TANK PUMPERS:</u> Rule 13.04 of the Illinois Private Sewage Disposal Code requires that each licensed contractor engaged in sludge disposal file a statement with the Department advising the location and methods of disposal of domestic sewage sludge. This information must be amended each year when replying for your registration certificate.
