# CROSSVIEW'S SUMMER STAFF INFORMATION

## Staff Counselors

- Positions Available: 4 (2 male & 2 female)
- Pay: \$50/day
- Must be at least 18 years old & graduated from high school
- Stay in Cabins with maximum of 9 Campers & a Volunteer Counselor
- Work with Volunteer Counselors to lead a different team of Campers each week
- Love on & mentor Campers
- Enforce CrossView's rules for Campers & Counselors
- Facilitate Campers as they do daily Cabin cleaning for daily inspection
- Weekly Cleaning/Chores



## Multi Purpose Staff

- Positions Available: 6 (usually 3 males & 3 females)
- Pay: \$50/day
- Must be at least 18 years old & graduated from high school
- Set up, facilitate, & clean up activities (ropes course, paintball, range sports, low ropes, fishing, canoeing, craft, hiking, pool activities, etc.)
- Perform skits
- Execute assigned daily & weekly cleaning tasks & other chores
- Lead Small Groups
- Apply spiritual parallel at each activity
- Among the 7 Multi Purpose Staff are several specific positions:

### Praise & Worship Leader

### Lifeguards (minimum 2)

**Lead Ropes Course Facilitator**—keeps Course Logs, inspects equipment, responsible for set up/take down of equipment, supervises course

**Safety Officer**—administers first aid, administers all Camper & Counselor medications, keeps Medical Log

**Senior Staff**—experienced Staff member who serves as an Assistant to the Camp Director, supervises weekly Cabin cleaning & chores

## Kitchen Staff

### Cook

- Positions Available: 1 or 2, depending on desired schedule
- Pay: \$7.25/hour
- Must be at least 18 years old & graduated from high school
- Prepares meals & snacks from meal plan with recipes
- Oversees Intern
- Performs daily & weekly cleaning of kitchen & dining hall
- Maintain temperature logs & meal count forms

### Intern

- Positions Available: 1 intern per week
- Pay: this is a volunteer position
- Must be at least 16 years old
- Helps the Cook(s) (wash dishes, set up serving line, clean, prep food, etc.)
- Photographs Camp activities
- Refills water coolers at stations
- Performs daily & weekly cleaning of kitchen & dining hall
